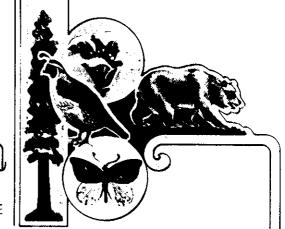

CERTIFICATE OF AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

CAL GAS-HAILEY

- A. C. TIEDEMAN and DARYL A. GAULT hereby certify:
- 1. They are the President and Secretary respectively of Cal Gas-Hailey, a California corporation.
- 2. At a meeting of the Board of Directors of the corporation duly held at Sacramento, California, on January 3, 1977, the following resolution was adopted:

whereas, it is deemed to be to the best interests
of the corporation and to the best interest of its
sole shareholder that its Articles of Incorporation be
amended as hereinafter provided:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Article One of the Articles of Incorporation of this corporation be amended to read as follows:

"One: The name of this corporation is CAL GAS-TWIN FALLS, INC."

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Board of Directors of this corporation hereby adopts and approves said amendment of its Articles of Incorporation.

- 3. The number of shares of said corporation which have consented in writing to the adoption of said amendment eight thousand two hundred, and the wording of the amended Article as set forth in the Written Consent executed by the holder of said shares is the same as that set forth in the Directors' Resolution.
- 4. That the total number of shares entitled to vote on or consent to said amendment is eight thousand two hundred (8,200).
