

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
of
SETTLERS' CO-OPERATIVE COMPANY.

We, the undersigned, citizens and residents of Butte County, Idaho, do hereby associate ourselves and do hereby make and execute the following Articles of Incorporation, and do hereby unite for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we hereby certify:

ARTICLE I.

That the name of this corporation shall be Settlers' Co-operative Company.

ARTICLE II

The purposes of this corporation are to reclaim and cultivate lands filed upon by the stockholders of this corporation under the Act of Congress of the United States known as an Act "to provide for an enlarged homestead," and permitting homestead entries of the public lands in Idaho, approved June 17, 1910, (Ch.298, 36 Stat. L. 531), and to buy and sell real estate, agricultural implements, warehouses for storage purposes, seeds, agricultural and horticultural products, dairy products and livestock, lumber, coal, and other similar products and commodities.

ARTICLE III.

The location of the general office and the place where the principal business of said corporation is to be transacted is at the town of Aroo, Butte County, Idaho.

ARTICLE IV

The term of the existence of said corporation shall be

The number of directors of said corporation shall be nine.

ARTICLE VI

The amount of the Capital Stock of this corporation is fixed at Twenty-five Thousand (\$25,000.00) Dollars, which is divided into Twenty-five Thousand shares of the par value of One (\$1.00) Dollar each.
