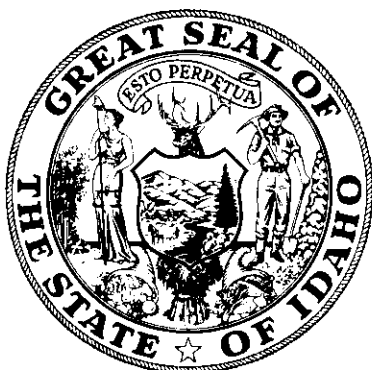

CERTIFICATE OF CORPORATION

OF THE

QUICK RESPONSE UNIT OF ATLANTA, INCORPORATED

1. We, the undersigned, all being of full age and being citizens of the United States of America and residents of the State of Idaho, for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation under the Idaho Business Act and Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act, do hereby certify and set forth:

1. The name of said corporation shall be: "Quick response Unit of Atlanta, Incorporated."

2. The Quick Response Unit of Atlanta, Incorporated shall be a nonprofit corporation.

3. The duration of said nonprofit corporation shall be perpetual.

4. The purposes for which said nonprofit corporation is to be formed are as follows:

A. To provide emergency care for ill and injured persons, and to perform rescue-extrication when necessary, within the limitations of the knowledge and skills afforded members by the Quick Response Unit training course and within the geographic limits for response as defined by the Director of the office of Emergency Health Services, until the arrival of an ambulance summoned by members that will transport the patient to a hospital.

B. To continue to upgrade the knowledge and skills of members for emergency care of ill and injured persons through periodic training sessions, of which there shall be no less than one every three months.

C. To promote community understanding of accident prevention and first aid techniques.

D. To engage in any and or all lawful business activities, but specifically pertaining to the health and welfare of the people of the Atlanta community.

5. The number of officers of said nonprofit corporation shall be six (6).
