ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the incorporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

THE NEW METHOD, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **fourteenth** day of **February**, A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **forty-six** and was recorded on **February 14, 1946** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **all purposes** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located **Boise** in the County of **Ada**.

and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

HYDE PARK MISSION, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the undersigned full-age citizens of the United States have this day voluntarily associated themselves together for the purpose of forming, and there is hereby formed, a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, Chapter 11 of Title 30, Idaho Code, and do hereby certify and agree as follows:

I.

The name of this corporation is Hyde Park Mission, INC.

II.

The location and post office address of the corporation's registered office is Boise, Ada County, Idaho. - 1519 - N 13th St.

III.

The purposes of this corporation are to establish and maintain a local place of worship of Almighty God, our Heavenly Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ, His Son, through the Holy Spirit and for the promotion of Christian fellowship and teaching of the Holy Scriptures, within and without the United States of America, and to that end to acquire, own, hold, manage and dispose of such parcel or parcels of real estate, together with buildings and improvements, as may be deemed necessary or desirable for or in connection with any of the purposes of the corporation; to construct, erect, purchase, or otherwise acquire, maintain and operate churches, schools and other church buildings and facilities; to sell or otherwise dispose of or exchange for other property, real or personal, acquired by the corporation. but not longer deemed necessary for its purposes, to borrow money and incur indebtedness for the purposes of the corporation, and to issue bonds, notes, mortgages or deeds of trust to evidence or secure the same; to receive, hold, invest, expand and apply to the purposes of the corporation, or any of them, gifts, contributions, pledges, offerings, devises and bequests of money or property; to establish and adopt By-laws and constitution; and make all rules and regulations deemed necessary and expedient for the management of the corporation and its affairs; but the foregoing enumeration of powers shall not be deemed or construed to be exclusive of, or a limitation upon, such other and general powers permitted or granted by law, which are in keeping with, or in aid

of, the general purposes of the corporation.

IV.

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

V.

This corporation is not organized for pecuniary profit and it shall not have or issue any capital stock. Membership in the corporation shall not entitle a person to any interest whatsoever in the assets of the corporation, but only to participate in the management of the affairs of the corporation, in meetings of the members legally called and held within the period covered by the membership.

VI.

The members of this corporation shall not be subject to assessments for the purpose of paying expenses, conducting business or paying debts of the corporation.

VII.

The governing body of the corporation shall consist of a Board of Deacons of not less than three and not more than ten members, each to be elected for a period of three years, however the pastor of the church shall be the president of the corporation and the chairman of the Board of Deacons, by virtue of his office. There shall be only one Board of Deacons of this corporation, and this Board of Deacons shall be the directors of the corporation and shall have the power to manage the affairs of the corporation, including, but not limited to the management of the real estate of the corporation and to carry on the promotion, operation and maintenance of such corporation; however, the aforementioned Board of Deacons shall have no power to buy, sell, mortgage, lease or otherwise transfer or encumber property of the church without first receiving authority from the congregation of the church so to do, after a meeting of the congregation has been regularly called for such purpose according to the duly enacted By-Laws of this corporation, and a majority of those members of the congregation present having voted in the affirmative to so instruct the deacons. Nor shall the deacons have exclusive control over the use of the church and the church property until said deacons have been instructed by a majority vote of the members of the congregation as aforesaid.

VIII.

All powers of the corporation shall be and remain vested in the Board of Deacons and active members, and shall include, but not be limited to, the power to adopt and amend and repeal By-Laws of the corporation, for the government thereof, not inconsistent with these Articles of Incorporation.

IX.

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 11 of title 30 and Section 30-1112, Idaho Code, it is hereby certified that an election was duly noticed and held for the election of five members of the Board of Deacons to comprise the Board of Directors of this corporation, as provided for and required by said Section 30-1112; that said election was held on the 4th day of February, 1966, at the hour of 7:45 P. M. at the Hyde Park Mission in Boise, Idaho.

That notice of said election was published for at least two weeks in The Kuna Herald, a newspaper published in said City of Kuna, the form of said notice and proof of publication thereof being attached to and filed with these Articles; that said notice was also posted in a conspicuous place on the aforementioned building, where said election was to be held, for at least two weeks prior to the date of said election, proof of said posting being attached to and filed with these Articles: that a majority of the members of this association who were present at said meeting voted at such election, and that, at and by such election, the persons whose names and addresses are hereinafter set forth were duly elected deacons, and to comprise the Board of Deacons of this corporation and association, to serve for the terms set after their names, and until their respective successors are elected and qualify as hereinabove set forth in these Articles:
