## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

## T.F.R. ELECTRONICS, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of the corporation under the Idaho Business Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

I.

The name of the corporation is "T.F.R. ELECTRONICS, INC."

II.

The period of its duration is perpetual.

III.

The purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

(a) To develop, manufacture, assemble, fabricate, import, lease, purchase or otherwise acquire, invest in, hold, use, license the use of, install, handle, maintain, service or repair, assign, and otherwise dispose of, and generally to trade and deal in and with, as principal or agent, at wholesale, retail, on commission, or otherwise, electronic systems, equipment and components, and electrical, mechanical, and electro-mechanical apparatus and equipment or every kind and description, electronic, telecommunication, communication, transmitting, receiving, recording, reproducing, and similar equipment, radio, sonar, radar, television, and related devices and equipment, and similar goods, wares, merchandise, commodities, articles of commerce, and property of every kind and description, and any and all products, machinery, equipment, and supplies used or useful in connection therewith.

- (b) To acquire, own, operate and conduct any type of electronic establishment and to purchase, acquire, exchange, lease (either as lessor or lessee), sell, dispose of and generally deal in any and all types of goods, wares and merchandise, including (without limitation to) electronic materials, supplies, machinery and equipment.
- (c) To form, create, organize or participate in any partnership, either as a general or limited partner, domestic or foreign,
  located in or organized under the laws of any authority in any part
  of the world.
- (d) To organize, finance and aid by loan, subsidy, guaranty, contribution to capital or surplus, or otherwise, any corporation, association, partnership, cyndicate, entity, person or governmental, municipal or public authority, domestic or foreign, located in or organized under the laws of any authority in any part of the world, any security of which is held directly or indirectly by or for the corporation, or in the business, financing or welfare of which the corporation shall have any interest; and in connection therewith to guarantee by endorsement or otherwise the payment of the principal of, or interest or dividends on, any such security of the foregoing; and generally to do any acts or things designed to protect, preserve, improve or enhance the value of any such security.
- (e) To undertake and carry on any business transaction for the purpose of establishing and participating in franchise licenses and systems or any business transaction or operations carried on or undertaken by promoters, financiers, contractors, merchants, commission men or agents.
- (f) To transact the business of buying and selling, dealing in, leasing, renting and managing real estate and any interest therein for its own account, as agent or broker, or on commission, to sell,

manage, improve, develop, assign, transfer, convey, lease, sublease, pledge, or otherwise encumber the lands, buildings, real property, chattels real, and other property of the company, real and personal, and wheresoever situated, and any and all legal and equitable rights therein.

- (g) To take, buy, purchase, exchange, hire, lease or otherwise acquire, real estate and property, either improved or unimproved, and any interest or right therein, and to own, hold, control, maintain and manage the same.
- (h) To purchase, sell and manufacture, and deal in building materials, goods, wares and merchandise, and to carry on any other lawful trade or business incident to or proper or useful in connection with the purchase, sale, ownership, construction, maintenance and management of real property.
- (i) To purchase or otherwise acquire, undertake, carry on, improve and develop all or any of the business, good will, rights, assets or liabilities of any person, firm, association or corporation, carrying on any kind of business, the same as, or with similar nature to, that which this corporation is authorized to carry on pursuant to the provisions of this certificate.
- and mining business; to drill, operate and maintain oil, gas and mining business; to drill, operate and maintain oil, gas and mineral leases, rights and interests in property for the production of oil, gas, hydrocarbons, uranium, minerals and ores of every kind and nature in liquid, gaseous, or solid form; and to excavate, construct, erect, equip and maintain wells, mines, shafts, quarries and excavations below and upon the surface; and further, to build, construct, maintain and operate refineries, plants, mills, smelters or any othersstructures for the making and manufacturing of the products therefrom; and to build, operate and sell tank farms, pipelines, pump stations and other structures necessary for or incidental

to a general oil and gas mining business; to purchase, lease or otherwise acquire, hold, develop, sell and deal in oil and gas leases, rights, royalties and estates of every nature therein, producing and otherwise; to acquire, hold, improve and sell and deal in machinery and equipment of whatever nature or kind necessary for or incidental to the operation of a general oil and/or gas mining business; and further, to buy and sell oil and/or gas or other hydrocarbons, or by-products thereof; and to acquire, by purchase, lease or otherwise, or to erect, construct, maintain and operate bulk and storage plants, filling stations, stores and other facilities for marketing and selling, wholesale or retail, of its products and by-products.

- (k) To purchase or otherwise acquire, apply for, register, hold, use, sell, license or contract inventions, improvements, processes, formulae, trade names, rights and licenses protected under letters patent, copyrights, recognized or otherwise, issued under the laws of the United States or any foreign country, insofar as such may be necessary or intended to carry out the business of this corporation; for the warehousing and transportation necessary in the purchasing, distributing and sales, manufacturing and operation of this corporation in these United States or any foreign country.
- (1) To purchase, own, hold, sell, pledge and otherwise acquire and dispose of and deal in and with the shares of capital stock and the bonds, notes and other evidences of indebtedness of corporations, wherever organized, and certificates of interest or other evidence of interest in any trust or other legal entity having and issuing certificates or other evidence of ownership in business or industrial enterprises.
- (m) To borrow money and to issue notes, stocks, bonds, debentures and other evidences of indebtedness and execute mortgages,

liens, and other encumbrances upon the property of the corporation, real or otherwise, to secure the payment of such notes, mortgages and other securities and evidence of debts; to construct, repair and maintain buildings and other improvements thereon and to rent the same and collect and invest the income therefrom.

- (n) To conduct business in this state, or other states, the District of Columbia, the territories, possessions and dependencies of the United States and in foreign countries and to have one or more offices out of this state, and to hold, lease, purchase, mortgage and convey real and personal property, both inside and outside this state, necessary and requisite to carry out the objects of the corporation.
- (o) The transaction of any and other lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Idaho Business Corporations Act.

The foregoing shall be construed both as objectives and powers and the enumeration thereof shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the general powers of the corporation, and the corporation shall have, possess and exercise any and all other powers, express or implied, as may be incidental to the conduct and transaction of its business and affairs or necessary or expedient for the attainment of its corporate purposes, and such other powers as may now or hereafter be conferred upon the corporation under the Constitution and laws of the State of Idaho.

IV.

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 3108 1/2 Sixth Street, Lewiston, ID 83501, and the name of its registered agent is W. Alan Hopkins.

٧.

The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall

have authority to issue is fifty thousand (50,000), having a par value of ten cents (\$.10) per share.

VI.

The number of directors of the corporation shall be as, from time to time, specified in the Bylaws of the corporation. The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors of the corporation is three (3), and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as directors until the first annual meeting of shareholders or until their successors are elected and shall qualify are:
