at Headquarters in the County of Clearwater and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

THE HEADQUARTERS UNITED PROTESTANT CHURCH, INC.

A Religious Corporation

We, the undersigned, being all citizens of the United States and of the State of Idaho and residents of Headquarters or vicinity in Clearwater County in said state, and being all members of the Headquarters United Protestant Church, hereby associate ourselves together with the purpose of forming a religious corporation pursuant to Chapter 11 of Title 30, Idaho Code, and all acts supplemental thereto and amendatory thereof, and we hereby certify:

That at a meeting of the members of said church held at the Pierce Community Church, at the southeast corner of water street and Stover Drive, in Pierce, Clearwater County, Idaho, at the hour of eight o'clock p.m., on Tuesday, September 27, 1966, for the purpose of forming a religious corporation of the members of said church under the name of "The Headquarters United Protestant Church, Inc.", a religious corporation, providing that said corporation shall have perpetual succession, adopting by-laws for said corporation and electing six trustees thereof, and for the purpose of transacting any and all other business that the members present deemed it expedient to transact in connection with said incorporation of said church, prior to which meeting and election notice of the time and place thereof was given in the manner and form required by law, by publication for at least two weeks in the Clearwater Tribune, a weekly newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the City of Orofino, Clearwater County, Idaho, a copy of which notice as printed and published is hereto attached, marked "Exhibit A", and by reference made a part hereof, and by posting a like notice in a conspicuous place on the bulletin board of the Pierce Community Church where such meeting and election were held and also by posting a like notice on the door of the Community Hall in Headquarters, Idaho, both postings being for the same length of time, at which meeting there were seven members of said church present, the undersigned were elected

trustees of said church to hold office until the election and qualification of their successors at the first annual meeting of said church thereafter, and were authorized to adopt and certify the following **Articles of Incorporation**, to-wit:

ARTICLE I
(Name)

The name of this corporation shall be **THE HEADQUARTERS UNITED
PROTESTANT CHURCH, INC.**

ARTICLE II
(Term)

The term of existence of this corporation is unlimited, and it shall have perpetual succession and existence from and after the date of incorporation.

ARTICLE III
(Purposes)

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

To establish and maintain a church in the Village of **Pierce**, County of **Clear-**
water, State of **Idaho**, and in connection therewith a suitable and customary organization
for the purpose of public worship and religious training under the protestant faith,
subject, however, in its government to the **Rules and Discipline** of the **Methodist**
Church, under the supervision of the **Pacific Northwest Conference** of the **Methodist**
Church; to purchase or otherwise acquire, hold, manage, sell, mortgage, and otherwise
encumber or dispose of real or personal property of any kind whatsoever, subject, how-
ever, in the encumbering or disposition of the same to the **Rules and Discipline** of the
Methodist Church; to receive, hold, and enjoy gifts, devises, and legacies; to borrow
money; to execute and issue notes and bonds evidencing its indebtedness and to secure
indebtedness by pledge, mortgage, or other encumbrance of its property; to rent and
lease real property; to do any and all things convenient and incidental to the purposes
herein expressed; and generally to have and exercise all such powers as are by law
conferred on corporations of like character and without in any particular limiting any of

the objectives or purposes or powers of the corporation, the objectives and purposes of the corporation shall be from time to time to do any one or more or all of the acts and things herein set forth, and all such acts, things, and business in any manner connected therewith or necessary, incidental, convenient, or auxiliary thereto or calculated, directly or indirectly, to promote the interests of the corporation or the members thereof or to enhance the value of any of its property or rights as such corporation may lawfully do; and in carrying on its objectives and purposes or for the purpose of attaining any of its objects, to do any and all things and exercise any and all other powers not prohibited by law or the Rules and Discipline of the Methodist Church.

ARTICLE IV
(Principal Office and Post Office Address)

The place where the principal office of this corporation shall be maintained and its principal place of business is at Headquarters, Clearwater County, Idaho, and the post office and registered address of this corporation in the State of Idaho shall be Headquarters, Idaho.

ARTICLE V
(Membership)

The members of this corporation shall be all persons who are now or who may hereafter become members of the Headquarters United Protestant Church.

ARTICLE VI
(Trustees or Directors)

The number of trustees or directors of this corporation shall be not less than six and not more than fifteen persons, and the number, qualification, terms of office, manner of election, time, place, and manner of calling meetings shall be prescribed by the by-laws. The Board of Trustees or directors shall have the management of the real estate and personal property of the corporation and shall be in charge of the

promotion, operation, and maintenance of the corporation, for the use of the members of this corporation and the properly constituted church authorities. The Board of Trustees or directors shall also be members of the official board of the Headquarters United Protestant Church.

The following persons were elected on September 27, 1966, to serve on the Board of Trustees or directors until the first annual meeting of the members of this corporation thereafter and until their successors are elected and qualified:
