KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, George W. Shaw and Arthur W. Lammers, of the city of Spokane, Washington, do hereby associate ourselves together under the laws of the state of Washington authorizing the formation of private corporations; and do hereby adopt the following articles of incorporation, to-wit:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be "S. H. L. Lumber Company, Limited."

ARTICLE II.

The objects for which this corporation is formed are as follows, viz:

First.-To deal in lands and realty of whatsoever nature or description; and to improve, hold as lessee, mortgagee or otherwise, own and enjoy the same.

Second.-To deal in timber, lumber and other forest products of whatsoever nature and kind; to engage in the manufacture of lumber and other timber products; and to build, purchase, own, hold as lessee, mortgage or otherwise, maintain and operate saw mills and any and all other manufacturing plant necessary or proper for the manufacture of lumber or other timber products.

Third.-To engage in the business of catching, booming, sorting, rafting, driving and holding logs, lumber or other timber products; and to deepen, straighten, clear and improve rivers and streams; and to do any and all things whatsoever to facilitate the business of catching, booming, sorting, rafting, driving and holding logs, lumber or other timber products; and to charge, collect and receive tolls therefor.

Fourth.-To enter, appropriate, locate, purchase, or otherwise acquire, hold as lessee, mortgagee or otherwise, construct, own, improve and maintain, water and water rights, water powers, mill and other

sites, ditches, canals, aqueducts, flumes, reservoirs, and any and all other means and devices for the utilization, storage or conveyance of water; and any or all easements necessary or convenient therefor.

Sixth.-To construct, purchase, or otherwise acquire, hold as lessee, mortgage or otherwise, own, maintain, and operate, electric, or other light or power plants or systems, and water plants or systems, including irrigation plants; and to supply, furnish and sell, water, light and power; and to transport and convey the same to any and all points of consumption; and to acquire in any lawful manner, hold as lessee, mortgage, or otherwise, own, maintain and operate all lines, manufacturing plant, machinery, pipe lines, ditches, canals, or other means necessary or convenient for such purposes; and any and all municipal licenses or franchises.

Sixth.-To engage in transportation of persons, property, messages and sounds; and to construct, purchase, or otherwise acquire, hold as lessee, mortgage or otherwise, own, maintain and operate, railways, whether operated by electricity or otherwise, trams, boats and vessels of any or all kinds, stage, express and freight lines, telegraph and telephone lines, and any and all other means whatsoever by which persons, property, messages or sounds may be transported or transmitted; and to charge, collect and receive tolls therefor.

Seventh.- To buy, sell, negotiate and guaranty the payment of notes, bills of exchange, or other negotiable paper, bonds, mortgages and other evidence of indebtedness.

Eighth.-To carry on any mercantile business; and to engage in manufacturing of any kind.

Ninth.-To locate, enter, purchase, or otherwise acquire, hold as lessee, mortgage or otherwise, own and operate, coal mines and coal lands; and to engage in the mining, buying and selling of coal.

Tenth.-To buy and sell, and negotiate the purchase and sale, of any and all kinds of property upon commission as broker, factor or otherwise.

Eleventh.-To buy, sell, own, hold, and deal in stocks and corporate securities of all kinds, tax titles and tax certificates.

Twelfth.-To sell, convey, transfer, mortgage, pledge, lease, demise, or otherwise dispose of, any and all properties, property rights or interests, which this company may acquire, receive or held.

Thirteenth.-To appropriate, purchase, or otherwise acquire, hold and own, any and all franchises, easements, licenses, or other property or rights, and to do any and all things, necessary, proper or convenient for carrying out the objects and accomplishing the purposes for which this corporation is formed.

#### ARTICLE III.

The amount of the capital stock of this corporation shall be twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00); which shall be divided into two hundred and fifty shares of the par value of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) each.

#### ARTICLE IV.

The time of the existence of this corporation shall be fifty (50) years.

#### ARTICLE VI.

The number of trustees who shall manage the concerns of this corporation, shall be three; and George W. Shaw, John J. Herlihy and Arthur W. Lammers, shall be and act as such trustees until the 21st day of April, A. D. 1906.

#### ARTICLE VI.

The principal place of business of said corporation shall be at the city of Spokane, Washington; Provided, however, that meetings of the trustees of said corporation may be held for the transaction of corporate business at other places, upon due notice given as may be prescribed in the by-laws of said corporation.


