I, JAS H. YOUNG, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

THE VALLEY GOSPEL ASSEMBLY, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **9th** day of **June** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Fifty-eight** and is duly recorded on Film No. **103** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Pinehurst** in the County of **Shoshone** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

TO SECRETARY OF STATE, STATE OF IDAHO:

BE IT KNOWN that on the 23rd day of May 1958, an election was held by the members of the congregation of the Valley Gospel Assembly, Pinehurst, Idaho; which election was held in the church building in Pinehurst, Idaho, at 8:00 pm; that a majority of the members of said congregation who were present at this meeting voted at said election; and that as a result of said election, the following trustees were elected:

- Wayne Dorsett, Smelterville, Idaho - trustee for three year term
- Micky Doyle, 611 Park, Kellogg, Idaho - trustee for two year term
- Harold McNelly, Smelterville, Idaho - trustee for one year term, and

BE IT ALSO KNOWN that in compliance with the state statutes governing religious corporations, legal notice of such election was published in the Kellogg - News - Wardner, a newspaper published Daily (Mon, Fri.) (Kellogg Evening News) in the County of Shoshone, State of Idaho, and BE IT FURTHER KNOWN, that such legal notice was published for a period of two consecutive weeks, and that a copy of said legal notice was posted on the church building of the Valley Gospel Assembly, Pinehurst, Idaho, for the same length of time, all such legal notices being published and posted prior to the holding of said election.

ARTICLE I. PURPOSES & NAME

The name of this corporation shall be The Valley Gospel Assembly, Inc. It shall be a non-profit, religious corporation. The purposes of this Corporation shall be to establish and maintain a place of Divine worship; to conduct under the guidance of the Holy Scriptures the work of the Church; to establish such departments as may be necessary to effectually carry out these purposes; to have the right to hold in trust, own, use or otherwise possess, and to sell, convey, mortgage, lease or otherwise dispose of or manage such property, real or personal, as may be needed for the purposes of the Church.

ARTICLE II. DURATION

The duration of this Corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III. REGISTERED ADDRESS

The location and postoffice address of said corporation shall be The Valley Gospel Assembly, Inc., Pinehurst, Idaho.

ARTICLE IV. CONSTITUTION & BY-LAWS

The Corporation shall have the power to adopt a constitution and by-laws consistent with the provisions of the Laws of Idaho and with these Articles of Incorporation. The Constitution so adopted must be ratified by a two-thirds vote of the legal voting membership of the Church at any regular or special business meeting of the congregation, and may be amended by the same two-thirds majority at any regular or special business meeting; by-laws may be adopted by a majority vote of the legal voting membership of the Church at any regular or special business meeting, and may be amended by the same majority at any regular or special business meeting.
