**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned individual, acting as incorporator under the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation

Act, adopts the following articles of incorporation:

ARTICLE I

CORPORATE NAME

The name of the corporation is Support MSD Students Inc. ("Corporation").

ARTICLE II

STATUS AND DURATION

Corporation is a nonprofit corporation and shall be organized and operated exclusively as an entity exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c) of the *Internal Revenue Code* or the corresponding provisions of any future federal tax law. The Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Corporation is to promote educational opportunities for students attending Moscow School District schools and to transact any lawful activity that may be carried on by a corporation under the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act.

ARTICLE IV

NON-MEMBER CORPORATION

The Corporation shall not have members, as that term is defined in the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act.

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ARTICLE V

LIMITATIONS ON ACTIVITIES

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c) of the *Internal Revenue Code* or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax law.

ARTICLE VI

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Corporation's board of directors shall consist of three (3) persons. The names and addresses of the persons who are to act as the initial directors of the Corporation until the election, designation or appointment of their successors are:

ARTICLE VII

DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS UPON DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution or final liquidation, after payment or provision for payment of all of the liabilities and/or obligations of the Corporation, the remaining assets of the Corporation shall, as determined by the board of directors, be distributed to an organization organized and operated exclusively as an entity exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding provisions of any future federal tax law.

ARTICLE VIII

BYLAWS

The Corporation's board of directors shall have the power by vote of all directors then in office to adopt bylaws as may be deemed necessary or convenient for the proper government and management of the business and affairs of Corporation and may by vote of all directors then in office amend, alter, or repeal such bylaws at any regular meeting or at any special meeting of the board of directors called for that purpose.

ARTICLE IX

REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

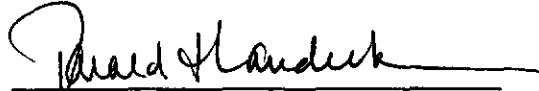
