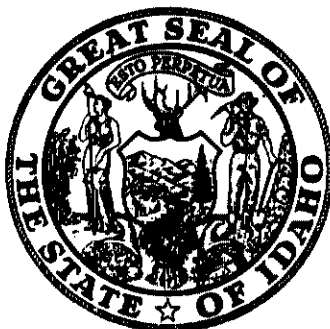
CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION OF

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

THE D.A.R.E. ASSOCIATION OF MADISON COUNTY, INC.

A Nonprofit Corporation

The following Articles of Incorporation are hereby adopted pursuant to the Idaho Business Corporation Act:

1. Name.

The name of this nonprofit corporation is The D.A.R.E. Association of Madison County, Inc.

2. Nonprofit Corporation.

This corporation is a nonprofit corporation organized under the provisions of Idaho Code, Title 30, Chapter 3, which statutes are known as the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act.

3. Duration.

This nonprofit corporation shall have perpetual duration unless sooner dissolved, as provided by law.

4. Purposes.

The purpose of this corporation is to teach children to never take illegal drugs.

The corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, and exclusively in furtherance of such purposes shall carry out and promote such activities and projects as are consistent with these articles.

To achieve the specific purposes listed above, this nonprofit corporation shall have all power to perform those functions authorized for nonprofit corporations by the Idaho

Nonprofit Corporations Act including those functions and powers specifically enumerated in Section 30-307, Idaho Code.

5. Membership.

The corporation shall have members and the number, qualification, rights, privileges and duties, if any, of members and the procedure for admission to and different classes of membership shall be as set forth in the Bylaws of the corporation.

6. Registered Agent and Office.

The name of the initial registered agent and the address of the initial registered office of the corporation is Jim Wood of 58 North Highway Lane, Rexburg, Idaho 83440.

7. Directors.

The affairs of the corporation shall be conducted by a Board of Directors of not less than five nor more than fifteen members, the exact number of which shall, from time to time, be fixed by the Bylaws.

The initial Board of Directors who shall serve on an interim basis until the First Annual Meeting, at which time directors shall be formally elected are listed as follows:

9. Nonprofit Status.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Paragraph 4 hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing of distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
