

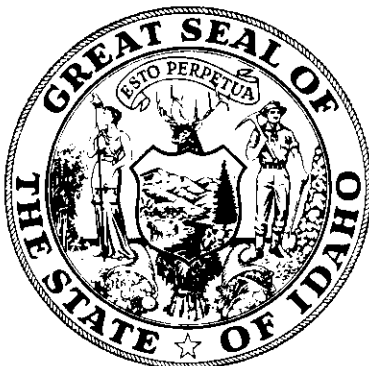

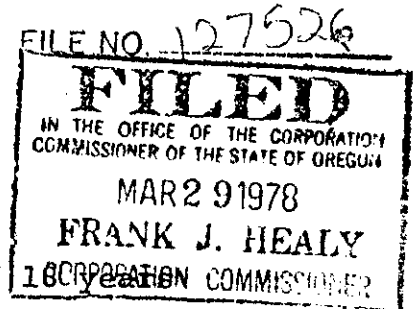

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
JONLAND CORPORATION



The undersigned natural person of the age of 18 years or more acting as incorporator under the Oregon Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is JONLAND CORPORATION and its duration shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE II

The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are to buy, sell and manage real estate and to engage in any lawful activity for which corporations may be organized under ORS Chapter 57.

ARTICLE III

The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is 1,000 no par value.

ARTICLE IV

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 2645 SW Upper Drive Place, Portland, Oregon, and the name of its initial registered agent at said address is John L. Johnson.


The shareholders shall not be denied statutory pre-emptory rights to acquire additional or treasury shares of the corporation.
