




1. The name of the corporation is C. C. I. PROPERTIES INTERNATIONAL, INC.
2. The period of its duration is perpetual.
3. Its purpose is to transact any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Idaho Business Corporation Act and, specifically, to engage foreign investors for domestic real estate.
4. It shall have authority to issue 5,000 shares of common stock, having a par value of \$1.00 per share.
5. The address of its initial registered office and the principal place of business is 1150 West State Street, Boise, Idaho. The name of its initial registered agent at such address is Lee Hill.
