ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

HIGH DESERT, INC.

The undersigned, acting as the incorporator of a corporation under the Idaho Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

- FIRST: The name of the corporation shall be HIGH DESERT, INC.
- SECOND: The purpose for which this corporation is organized is the transaction of any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Idaho Business Corporation Act.
- THIRD: The aggregate number of shares which the corporation is authorized to issue is 1,000 shares, all of which shares shall be common voting stock, and which shares shall have no par value.
- FOURTH: The street address of the registered office of the corporation is 2898 E. 800 N., Roberts, Idaho, and the name of the registered agent at such address is Thomas L. Buxton.
- FIFTH: The mailing address of the corporation shall be 2898 E. 800 N., Roberts, Idaho 83444.
- SIXTH: Directors need not be residents of the State of Idaho or shareholders of the corporation. The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors of the corporation is two (2) and the name and address of the persons who are to serve as directors until the first annual meeting of the shareholders or until their successors are elected and shall qualify are:

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
SEVENTH: No director shall be liable to the corporation or its stockholders for monetary damages for breach of fiduciary duty except liability for: (i) the amount of a financial benefit received by a director to which he is not entitled; (ii) an intentional infliction of harm on the corporation or the shareholders; (iii) a violation of § 30-1-833, Idaho Code; or (iv) an intentional violation of criminal law.

EIGHTH: The corporation shall indemnify the directors and officers of the corporation to the fullest extent permitted by the Idaho Business Corporation Act, as the same exists or may hereafter be amended (but, in the case of any such amendment, only to the extent that such amendment permits the corporation to provide broader indemnification rights than the Idaho Business Corporation Act permitted the corporation to provide prior to such amendment).

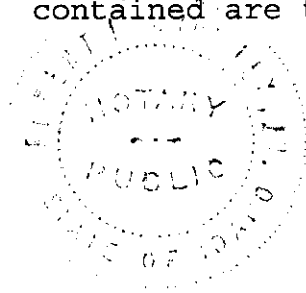


