A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

The undersigned acting as incorporator of a corporation hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation" under the provisions of the Idaho Non-profit Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I.

NAME

The name of the corporation is BRUNDAGE MOUNTAIN SKI EDUCATION FOUNDATION, INC., which corporation is a non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE II.

PERIOD OF DURATION

The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III.

PURPOSES AND POWERS

PURPOSES: The purpose of this corporation is to create, develop, and maintain a joint academic and competitive ski training and development program to students from elementary through high school age in coordination with the McCall-Donnelly Joint School District and local ski facilities.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION - Page 1

EXEMPT STATUS: The corporation is constituted so 2. as to attract substantial support from contributions, directly or indirectly, from a respresentative number of persons in the community in which it operates and has not been formed for pecuniary profit or financial gain, and no part of the assets, income, or profit of the corporation is distributable to. or inures to the benefit of, its directors, or officers except to the extent permitted under the Not-for-Profit Corporation Law. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervent in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this certificate, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 50) (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law>.

- 3. To engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under the laws of the State of Idaho.
- 4. To have the capacity to act possessed by natural persons in the performance of such acts as are necessary or proper to accomplish its purposes and which are not repugnant to law, including the right to accept, hold, invest and reinvest, and administer any donations, gifts, bequests, trust benefits, and the like, so long as same are ultimately used, disbursed or donated exclusively for the use and benefit of The Brundage Mountain Ski Academy and its programs.
- 5. To appoint such officers, employees and agents and the activities of the corporation may require and to make bylaws not inconsistent with any existing law for the management of its activities and the regulation and conduct of its affairs; to do all acts permitted by the laws of the State of Idaho, and all such other acts as are necessary and expedient to accomplish its stated purposes except as limited by the laws of the State of Idaho.
- 6. The foregoing clauses shall be construed both as Purposes and Powers, and it is hereby expressly provided that the foregoing enumberation of specific powers shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the powers of the corporation, save as set forth.

ARTICLE IV.

BYLAWS

The corporation shall be governed by the provisions set forth in the corporation's bylaws.

ARTICLE V.

MEMBERSHIP

The corporation shall not be a membership corporation.

In lieu thereof the board of directors shall be selected in part by the Brundage Mountain Company, an Idaho Corporation, as more particularly set forth in the Corporation by-laws.

ARTICLE VI.
