ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

Leo 8. Marshalfost. NO. 10, AMERICAN LEGION

KYOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, members of a local subdivision of The American Legion, a benovolent and patriotic society chartered and incorporated by act of Congress of September 16th, 1919, (Chapter 59, 41 Stat. L. 284) in accordance with the rules of such society and under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, incorporate ourselves and form a corporation as follows, to-with

That the name of this corporation is "Seo 8. Marshall

Post NO. 10, THE AMERICAN LEGION."

II.

That this corporation is formed for social, benevolent and patriotic purposes, and especially, but not in limitation of its general powers:

B. To cultivate social intercourse among its members and assist in improving the health and physical condition of its members.

- C. To acquire, by purchase of otherwise, own, hold, manage, lease, sell and convey such real and personal property, and erect such buildings, memorials, club houses and other structures as may be necessary or incident to the carrying out of the purposes herein mentioned; to borrow money for the furtherence of such purposes and to secure the same by obligations, pledges, mortgages, or the issuance of bonds or debentures secured by pledges, deeds of trust, or mortgages of or upon the whole or any part of its property; to take and receive donations of real and personal property by gift, grant, devise or bequest;
- athletic contests and social meetings of its members; to promote and conduct entertainments, amusements and diversions to defray the expenses of this corporation; to promote and encourage the sport, pleasure, exercise and recreation of its members, and to enter into any and all contracts necessary in conducting its affairs; and to lend money, and render such benevolent aid and comfort to its members as may be provided by its by-laws; and to do any and all other things whatsoever which may be requisite, necessary and proper in and about the carrying out of the purposes and objects for which this corporation is formed:

That the place where its principal place of business shall be is the city of Puber., state of Idaho.

That the term for which this corporation shall exist is fifty (50) years.
