I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the

PRESBYTERY OF SOUTHERN IDAHO

a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, filed in this office on the **Twelfth** day of **May**, 19**60**, original articles of amendment, as provided by Sections **30-146, 30-147 and 30-1103, Idaho Code, restating Articles of Incorporation and changing corporate name to PRESBYTERY OF KENDALL, INC.**

and that the said articles of amendment contain the statement of facts required by law, and are recorded on Film No. **111** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho.

I THEREFORE FURTHER CERTIFY, That the Articles of Incorporation have been amended accordingly.

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF THE PRESBYTERY OF SOUTHERN IDAHO

Known all men by these presents that the articles of incorporation of the Presbytery of Southern Idaho, formerly Twin Falls Presbytery, are amended to read as follows:

I

Article I shall read as follows:

The name of this corporation shall be the Presbytery of Kendall,
INC.

II

Article II shall read as follows:

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

1. To establish and maintain places of worship, and to hold property for churches organized within its jurisdiction.

2. To counsel and assist churches, and to enter into common measures for promoting knowledge and religion, and for preventing error and immorality.

3. To exercise such ecclesiastical government and control as is, or may be, in accordance with the laws of the United Presbyterian Church in the United States of America.

III

Article III shall read as follows:

The principal place of business of said corporation shall be at Pocatello, Idaho, provided general business of said corporation may be transacted at any place where a meeting of this Presbytery may be in session.

IV

Article IV shall read as follows:

The existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

V

Article V shall read as follows:

The affairs of this corporation shall be managed by a board of

seven directors, who shall be called trustees, the terms of said directors to be governed by the by-laws of this corporation.

VI

Article VI shall read as follows:

That the Presbytery of Kendall is a part of the Synod of Idaho, and a part of the General Assembly of the United Presbyterian Church in the United States of America; that pecuniary profit is not the object of this corporation; that the corporation is represented by its membership, as provided in the government of said church.

VII

Article VII shall be added as follows:

That the jurisdiction of this corporation shall cover all United Presbyterian churches in the United States of America located in the following counties of the state of Idaho: Bannock, Bear Lake, Bingham, Blaine, Bonneville, Butte, Camas, Caribou, Cassia, Clark, Custer, ~~Franklin~~, Fremont, Gooding, Jefferson, Jerome, Lemhi, Lincoln, Madison, Minidoka, Oneida, Power, Teton, and Twin Falls.

We the undersigned, being first duly sworn, depose and say: That we are the chairman and secretary, respectively, of the ^{Presbytery of} ~~Southern Idaho Presbytery~~, a corporation; that the foregoing amendments to the articles of incorporation of ^{of the Presbytery} ~~Southern Idaho Presbytery~~ were duly adopted by a majority of a quorum who attended a meeting of the members thereof, called as provided in the by-laws of said corporation and the laws of the state of Idaho; that public notice of the intention to amend the articles of incorporation was given by publication for once a week for four weeks in the ^{Herald Bulletin} a newspaper published in Cassia County, Idaho, in which such meeting was held; that such notice designated the regular meeting at which it was intended to vote on the proposition of amending the articles of incorporation, and stated the manner in which it was intended to amend said articles of incorporation; that a copy of said notice is as follows:
