## ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE PRESBYTERY OF SOUTHERN IDAHO

State of Idaho, : County of Cassia.

Known all men by these presents that the articles of incorporation of the Presbytery of Southern Idaho, formerly Twin Falls Presbytery, are amended to read as follows:

Article I shall read as follows:

The name of this corporation shall be the Presbytery of Kendall.

INC.

Article II shall read as follows:

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

- 1. To establish and maintain places of worship, and to hold property for churches organized within its jurisdiction.
- 2. To counsel and assist churchs, and to enter into common measures for promoting knowledge and religion, and for preventing error and immorality.
- 3. To exercise such ecclesiastical government and control as is, or may be, in accordance with the laws of the United Presbyterian Church in the United States of America.

Article III shall read as follows:

The principal place of business of said corporation shall be at Pocatello, Idaho, provided general business of said corporation may be transacted at any place where a meeting of this Presbytery may be in session.

Article IV shall read as follows:

The existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

Article V shall read as follows:

The affairs of this corporation shall be managed by a board of

seven directors, who shall be called trustees, the terms of said directors to be governed by the by-laws of this corporation.

Article: VI shall read as follows:

That the Presbytery of Kendall is a part of the Synod of Idaho, and a part of the General Assembly of the United Presbyterian Church in the United States of America; that pecuniary profit is not the object of this corporation; that the corporation is respessented by its membership, as provided in the government of said church.

VII

Article VII shall be added as follows:

That the jurisdiction of this corporation shall cover all United Presbyterian churches in the United States of America located in the following counties of the state of Idaho: Bannock, Bear Lake, Bingham, Blaine, Bonneville, Butte, Camas, Caribou, Cassia, Clark, Custer, Frank-Lin, Fremont, Gooding, Jefferson, Jerome, Lemhi, Lincoln, Madison, Minidoka, Oneida, Power, Teton, and Twin Falls.


