

Article 2: To preach and teach the biblical faith of Orthodox Christianity as handed down by the Celtic Orthodox church fathers. To dispense the sacraments of the Orthodox Christian church. To provide a non-profit legal entity for the needs of the Ancient Celtic Orthodox Church in northern Idaho, eastern Washington, and western Montana.

Article 8: After the payment of debts has been made, if any real or moveable assets remain, shall be sold and the monies obtained shall be donated to any 501(c)(3) Christian charity or church determined by the directors at the time of dissolution.

In the event that this non-profit corporation is dissolved in order to be replaced or succeeded by another non-profit, the succeeding non-profit shall inherit all assets remaining after the payment of the debts of this corporation, or the succeeding corporation may opt to absorb the debts of Holy Mother of the Blessed Sacrament, Inc. in addition to any assets which may remain.
