

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that we, the undersigned subscribers hereto have and do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of organizing a CORPORATION by virtue of the laws of Idaho.

1 The name of said corporation is THE LITTLE WOOD RIVER CANAL COMPANY.

2 The purpose for which it is formed is to carry on and conduct the business of constructing and maintaining canals and diverting water from Little Wood River for the irrigation of lands lying and being in what is known as the Little Wood River Valley, in Blaine County, Idaho, and its vicinity, and for the use of said water for manufacturing, milling and other purposes, and to do any and all things necessary and convenient to be done in and about the premises; to acquire title to, own and sell all kinds of real property necessary for the construction of canals and dams, to convey, mortgage and hypothecate property acquired, and to take liens and mortgages upon all kinds of property in the course of its business.

3 The place where its principal business is to be transacted is at Carey, Blaine County, Idaho.

4 The term for which it is to exist is fifty years.

5 The number of its directors shall be five (which may be increased as provided by law) and the names and residences of those who are appointed for the first year are
