

REDFERNS OF STATE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
IDAHO NEWSPAPER FOUNDATION, INC.

WE, the undersigned, President and Secretary, respectively of IDAHO NEWSPAPER FOUNDATION, INC., a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Idaho, and located in Boise, Idaho, hereby certify:

1. The name of the corporation is IDAHO NEWSPAPER FOUNDATION, INC.

2. The Articles of Incorporation are amended by the following resolution adopted by the Board of Directors:

RESOLVED, that the Articles of Incorporation of IDAHO NEWSPAPER FOUNDATION, INC., shall be amended so that in addition to the present Article III of the existing Articles of Incorporation which reads as follows:

"ARTICLE III.

"Purposes

"The objects and purpose for which this corporation is formed are to conduct research into areas which contribute to knowledge in public communications, conduct educational projects which will advance the cause of free press in the state and nation, to offer scholarship support and to fund or partially fund internship studies for persons considered worthy of support so that they might contribute to improving the quality of journalism in the state or nation, and to make contributions from time to time to those individuals and/or organizations whose work is deemed to be in the interests of the development of the constitutional guarantees of free speech and open government. Said purposes shall include, but not be limited to the following:

"(a) To serve the public interest by encouraging, fostering, and aiding improvement in the quality, vigor and fairness of journalism and a free press in the State of Idaho

"(b) To make scholarships, grants, stipends, gifts and to provide financial aid to worthy students of journalism in the State of Idaho who show outstanding promise and achievement.

"(c) To make awards, grants and gifts to members of the journalism profession and to Idaho newspapers in recognition of outstanding achievement in reporting, writing, editing, photojournalism, and newspaper publishing.

"(d) To foster learning and sponsor research programs and projects.

"(e) To make financial donations and grants to Idaho colleges, universities, and other learning institutions to support and improve the quality of the teaching of journalism.

"(f) To promote public awareness in Idaho of the role of a free press in our Republic and to encourage public involvement in the activities of Idaho newspapers."

the following language should be added:

"This corporation is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

"Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

"Upon the winding up and dissolution of this corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the organization, the remaining assets should be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation or corporation which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code."

3. The above Resolution was adopted by a majority of the Directors at the Special Meeting held on July 23, 1983; there are no members of this corporation at this time.
