

1 Know all men by these Presents:—

2 That the undersigned have this day associated themselves  
3 together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the  
4 the Laws of the State of Idaho, and we do now declare  
5 and certify our Articles of Incorporation, and we do  
6 hereby accept the constitution of the State of Idaho.  
7

8 — First:—

9 The name of the corporation shall be:—

10 — "The Wake-Up - Iron Gold Mining Company"—

11 — Second:—

12 The purposes for which this corporation is formed are the  
13 mining, milling, reducing, crushing, and refining of  
14 gold and silver ores, copper ores, and ores containing  
15 other precious metals, and otherwise prepare the same  
16 for market. The purchasing and leasing and renting  
17 of mining properties, and the purchasing and leasing  
18 of ores containing precious metals, and the buying and  
19 selling and mortgaging of mining properties. The  
20 construction and erection of such smelting, milling, ~~min~~  
21 reductions and mining plants, Chlorination, cyanide  
22 or other plants as may be necessary in the reduction  
23 of the ores taken from the property owned or under bond  
24 and lease to the corporation, or bought or procured from  
25 other sources. The construction and operation of such  
26 railways, tramways, cables or other modes of conveyance  
27 and transportation as may be necessary in the treatment  
28 and transportation of the ores and mining material,  
29 and all kind of mining supplies or in the transportation  
30 of the ores or mining material and supplies from the  
31 mines to the mills, and to the market, and from the  
32 mills or from the market to the mines. The purchasing, leasing

2 and holding of such water rights, flumes, ditches, pipe lines or  
3 other water courses as may be necessary for the carrying on the  
4 business aforesaid. The construction of such engine houses,  
5 electric plants, water ditches, flumes, pipe lines or water  
6 power as may be necessary to furnish power to carry on the  
7 business of mining and reducing ores, and the trans-  
8 portation of material and supplies as aforesaid.

9 To carry on a general business of mining and transporting  
10 of material and supplies, and producing ores, and to  
11 hold such <sup>property</sup> ~~machinery~~, and to construct such machinery  
12 and works, and <sup>to</sup> do and perform all such acts as  
13 may be necessary and incident to a general mining  
14 business and transportation of mining materials and  
15 supplies. To buy, sell, and lease properties or ores,  
16 mining supplies, material and machinery, to convey  
17 the same to market, to locate mining claims, to buy,  
18 prospect, or lease mines or mining locations or mining  
19 properties and supplies, to exchange the same, to  
20 reduce ores for fire, and to purchase all kind of  
21 ores containing precious or other metals. To advance

24 and supplies, and the expenses incidental thereto

26 The place where the principal business of this corporation  
27 shall be transacted shall be in the City of Wallace,  
28 County of Shoshone, State of Idaho, and the company  
29 may have branch offices at other places in the  
30 United States, and the Dominion of Canada,  
31 or in any foreign Country —

32 — Fourth. —

1 The term for which this corporation shall exist shall be  
2 Fifty years. Fifth.
