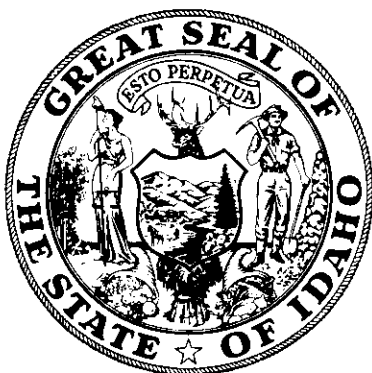

VII.


The corporation shall not have a board of directors; management of the affairs of the corporation shall be vested in its members.


