

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF THE
CHI DELTA PHI SORORITY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, we, the undersigned have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of incorporating under the Laws of the State of Idaho, a social, educational and benevolent corporation, whose objects are not pecuniary profit:-

And we certify as follows, to-wit;

- I. That the said corporation shall be known as the " CHI DELTA PHI SORORITY."
- II. That the objects for which said corporation is formed are the following:
 - (a) To develop the social , educational and benevolent qualifications of its members, and to promote the fraternal spirit of the sorority hereby incorporated.
 - (b) To acquire, hold, sell ,assign and convey property, whether real, personal or mixed, not for pecuniary profit, but such as shall be necessary for the carrying out of the aims whether herein named or not, for which this sorority is incorporated.
 - (c) To do and perform any, all and every act and deed requisite for the general welfare of said sorority, and for the attainment of the objects of this corporation.
- III. That the principal place of business of this corporation shall be the "CHI DELTA PHI SORORITY" house ,number 503 College Avenue, City of Moscow, State of Idaho.
- IV. That the term of this incorporation shall be fifty years.
- V. That the number of directors who shall have the management of its affairs shall be five, and the names of the directors for the organization, and for the first term of the corporation are :

- VI. That the said directors were elected at a meeting of the members of the CHI DELTA PHI SORORITY, duly convened and held at the CHI DELTA PHI SORORITY house, 503 College Avenue ,Moscow, Idaho for the purpose among others of electing directors to take charge and management of its affairs and property, and to form this incorporation . That notice of the holding of the said meeting was given by publication in the IDAHO POST ,a weekly news paper ,regularly published at Moscow, Idaho, and of general circulation, which notice appeared in three separate issues thereof prior to this meeting That a majority of the members were present and voted at said meeting and at said election for the above named five directors, as more fully appears from the certificate and verification by the officers who conducted the election, and hereby made part of these articles.

This is to certify ,that at a meeting of the members of the CHI DELTA PHI SORORITY, duly and regularly called by publication of the notice thereof and therefor fully setting forth the objects thereof, held at the CHI DELTA PHI SORORITY house, 503 College Avenue, the City of Moscow, Idaho, October 16th 1916, at the hour of

7:30 P.M. of that day, a majority of the members being present and voting at said election, Margaret Rawlings acted as president and Lyle Turner, as secretary thereof.

The meeting then proceeded to the election of five directors to take charge and management of the affairs and property of said sorority thus to be incorporated under the Laws of the State of Idaho, and to act as the directors of said corporation during the first term, that said election was by ballot, regularly conducted, and the following directors were unanimously elected for the purposes hereinbefore set forth:
