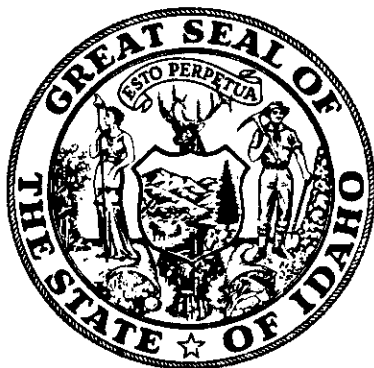

Please be advised that on January 8, 1989, a corporate annual meeting of our church was held, that a quorum was present, and that the following business of interest to your office was conducted:

Presiding president Del Martin reported that a search of the minutes of previous corporate meetings has failed to turn up any reference to a corporate name change for the church in harmony with the new denominational name following the reunion of the two major Presbyterian bodies in the United States. This discovery having been made even though several members recall a motion and an affirmative vote for the name change "a few years ago".

It was therefore moved and seconded to "renew and institute the official name change of this church from 'The United Presbyterian Church of Emmett, Idaho' to 'The First Presbyterian Church of Emmett, Idaho'". The motion passed unanimously. *Inc.*

Please regard this communication as our official Articles of Amendment regarding this name change. There were no other provisions altered in our articles of incorporation.
