That the said corporation shall be called and known by the name of the Utah and Idaho Land and Lumber Company, and shall be and is formed and organized at Salt Lake City, Utah.

That the Corporation herein provided for and hereby created, sooner shall exist and continue for the term of fifty years, unless dissolved and disincorporated according to law.

IV.

That the object pursuit and business of this corporation is and shall continue to be to manufacture lumber and all articles and things made of lumber, to buy and sell real estate, to irrigate lands, and to sell water, to buy and sell live stock, to own and operate railroads, tramways and steamboats, to engage in mercantile business, and to transact all other business except banking.

V.

That the place of the Géneral Offices of said Corporation, and of the general, financial and commercial business thereof shall be at Salt Lake City, Utah.

#### **V**1.

That the amount of the capital stock of said corporation shall be one Hundred Thousand Dollars, which shall be divided into one hundred thousand shares of the face or par value of one dollar each.

#### VII.

That the amount of stock subscribed and taken by each of the corporators above named, parties to this agreement, is as follows, to-wit:

carl J. Hahn, Trustee, -----40,000 shares and 50,000 shares are hereby reserved as treasury stock for the purpose of operating and conducting the business of the corporation.

#### V111.

That the officers of the corporation shall be:

First. A board of seven directors.

Second. A President.

Third. A Vice-President.

Fourth. A Treasurer.

Fifth. A Secretary.

Said officers of Secretary and Treasurer may be held by the same person, properly qualified. The President, Vice-President and Treasurer shall be Directors.

#### 1X.

That the qualifications of the officers of said corporation shall be as follows, that is to say: To be eligible to the office of Director, President, Vice-President, Treasurer or Secretary, the person must be the owner as shown by the books of the corporation, of at least one hundred shares of the capital stock of said corporation.

The following named persons, parties hereto, shall be directors of said corporation until the second Monday of Movember, 1905, and until their successors shall be duly elected at the first regular election of said corporation which shall be held on said second Monday of November, 1905, and shall have duly qualified, namely: A. Hanauer Jr., Walter A. Gooke, Carl J. Hahn, Gustave Kroeger, Joshua F. Spalding, George C. Blakeslee, and H. A. McCornick, and that the said A. Hanauer Jr., shall be President, the said Gustave Kroeger shall be vice-President, and the said Carl J. Hahn shall be Secretary and Treasurer for said term and until their successors shall be duly elected and qualified, and any

vacancy caused by the resignation, death or removal of either, or any of said directors or officers may be filled by the Board of Directors.

X1.

That the term of office of the officers of said corporation, except as in Article X. provided shall be one year and until their successors shall be elected and shall have duly qualified, unless sooner resigned or removed, as hereinafter provided.

X11.

That the annual stockholders meeting of the Corporation for the election of officers, and for the transaction of any such other business that shall lawfully come before it shall be held on the 2nd Monday of November of each year at Salt Lake City, Utah, at the general office of said corporation, a representation of a majority of the capital stock of said corporation shall be necessary to legally hold said meeting or any stockholders' meetings of said corporation, either general or special. The Directors of said corporation shall be elected by ballot and the persons receiving a majority of votes of stockholders at such meeting, shall be held and declared to be elected to said offices respectively. Each stockholder shall be entitled to as many votes as he holds shares of said capital stock, and representation by proxy duly appointed, shall be allowed at all meetings of said corporation, either general or special. The first officers herein named shall hold office until the 2nd Monday of November, 1908, unless sooner resigned or removed. It is hereby provided that a failure to hold any general meeting of the stockholders of said corporation at the day appointed for the same, shall not forfeit or in any way interfere with the corporate rights acquired under this agreement, but any such meeting may be held at any subsequent time, upon giving thirty days' notice by publication thereof in a weekly newspaper published at Salt Lake City, Utah. The Secretary shall, or in case of his failure, any other officer of said corporation may, give thirty days' previous notice of all Annual Stockholders' meetings by notice mailed to each stockholder of record, addressed to his last known rost Office address, and of all special stockholders' meetings, by notice both published and

mailed, in the same manner, but specifying the purposes for which any special meeting is called. No business shall be transacted at special meetings, except that particularly mentioned in the notice thereof.

#### XIII.
