THE UNDERSIGNED, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Idaho Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

FIRST

The name of the corporation is C2H Technologies, Inc.

SECOND

The period of its duration is perpetual.

THIRD

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is the transaction of any or all lawful business for which the corporation may be incorporated under the Idaho Business Corporation Act.

FOURTH

The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have the authority to issue is 100,000 with no par value.

FIFTH

Shareholders shall have a preemptive right to acquire unissued shares or securities convertible into such shares or carrying a right to subscribe to or acquire shares, except as provided in the Idaho Business Corporation Act.


