ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF THE

GOLDEN CHEST MINING AND MILLING COMPANY.

We the undersigned persons, residents of the State of Washington do hereby associate ourselves for the purpose of forming a corporation, and for that purpose execute these articles in triplicate.

I.

The name of this corporation shall be the Golden Chest Mining and Milling Company.

II.

The objects for which this corporation is formed are: to carry on the business of mining and locating all kinds of ore; to work, operate, buy, sell, lease, locate, acquire, procure, own, hold, and deal in mines, lands, metals and minerals of every description in the United States of America, of the Territory of Alaska, of the Republic of Mexico and of the Dominion of Canada, and to develop the same, to carry on and contract a general mining business, to purchase, acquire, own, hold, locate and operate electric light and power plants for the purposes of mining or otherwise and the treating of ores in any and all ways; for the further purposes of mining to bond, buy, own, lease, locate, sell, build and operate tramways or other means of transportation for the purposes of transporting ores, minerals and other materials; to own, bond, buy, sell, lease and locate timber and timber claims and finally to do anything and everything consistent, proper and requisite for the carrying out of all objects and purposes herein set forth in the fullest and broadest sense within the countries heretofore mentioned.

III.

The capital stock of this corporation shall be Fifty Thousand (\$50,000) Dollars, divided into five hundred thousand (500,000) shares, of the par value of Ten Cents (\$.10) a share.

IV.

The time of existence of this corporation shall be Fifty (50) years.

v.

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be in the City of Spokane, in the County of Spokane and the State of Washington.

VI.

The number of Trustees of this corporation shall be three (3) and the names of the first Trustees, who shall manage the affairs of this Company until January 1st, A. D. 1911 are the following, to-wit:
