was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Fifteenth** day
of **May** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-one** and
is duly recorded on Film No. **114** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State
of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103 and
Sections 30-1001 to 30-1005, inclusive, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and
successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for
perpetual existence from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at
Lewiston in the County of **Nez Perce,**
and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit Coopera-
tive Associations as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
of Snake River Rodeo Association, Incorporated

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, of full age and citizens of the United States, do hereby associate ourselves together to form a non-profit co-operative association pursuant to Section 30-1001, I. C. and the general laws of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be "Snake River Rodeo Association, Incorporated".

ARTICLE II

The purposes of the corporation shall be to organize, manage, sponsor, promote, to aid and to assist in rodeo and horsemanship events and contests; engage in the construction, building and repairing of facilities to carry out the purposes of the corporation; to work for fair and equitable treatment of contestants, standardization of rules and judging, fair and equitable division of prize money and any and all other things or matters which will promote amateur rodeo contests or horsemanship events, or the best interests of contestants in such events. The corporation shall have power to enter into contracts for and on behalf of the members of the corporation and shall have power to own, sell, lease, convey and encumber real and personal property and power to do all acts or things necessary to carry out the purposes hereinbefore expressed.

ARTICLE III

The location and postoffice address of the registered office in the State of Idaho shall be 503 Breier Building, Lewiston, Idaho.

ARTICLE IV

The rights and interest of all members shall be equal and no member can have or acquire a greater interest therein than any one member. No capital stock

shall be issued by the corporation. The corporation shall issue membership certificates to each member thereof which certificate cannot be assigned except by resolution by Board of Directors and under such regulation as the by-laws may prescribe.

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.




ARTICLE VII


