The purpose for which Rocky's Rescue, Incorporated is organized is to rescue abandoned animals primarily from county and city shelters.

At Rocky's Rescue, we are foster-based and set forth as a non-profit organization. This means that any animal entering into our care is placed into a loving foster home until they are successfully adopted. No animals are placed in boarding facilities, and no animals will be transferred to other facilities or rescues unless consent by the entire board is granted.

Rocky's Rescue's position is firm in providing rehabilitation, tenderness, and quality family care for every animal in our rescue. Potential adopters are required to fill out an application with references, attend a meet and greet with the animal, and open their home to a home visit conducted by a trained Rocky's Rescue representative. All adopters are required to sign an adoption contract and pay the appropriate fee.

Each animal is recognized as an individual and are assessed as such. Potential family matches are sought after, and the animal will not be placed without the consent of the Director or Co-director.

We are supported by donations, grants, and adoption fees. We are committed to serving the animals and the adopters as we all journey toward the goal of a safe home for each adoptable animal.
