CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, J. D. (CY) PRICE, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

INKOM ELEVATOR, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the fifth day of April A.D. One Thousand Nine Hundred fifty and duly recorded on Film No. 58 of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 29-103, Idaho Code, Annotated.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for perpetual existence from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at Pocatello in the County of Bannock

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

INKOM ELEVATOR, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, all of whom are bona fide residents of the State of Idaho, and full age citizens of the United States of America, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

I

That the name of said corporation is: INKOM ELEVATOR, INC.

II

Without in any way limiting the powers granted by the laws of the State of Idaho, the purposes for which said corporation is formed are as follows, to-wit:

To construct, acquire, operate, hire, lease, mortgage, sell or otherwise dispose of elevators for elevating wheat, grain or other produce, with the requisite sites, engines, plant, machinery, and appliances therefor; and also sheds, stores, and warehouses for the reception and storage of wheat, grain, and other produce, and any other goods, wares, merchandise and effects; and generally to carry on an elevator and storage business, and in connection therewith to acquire by lease, license, purchase or otherwise, hydraulic, electric, or other power and to utilize the same and dispose of any surplus power.

To buy and sell on commission or otherwise, at wholesale or retail, butter, milk, cheese and all other dairy products, eggs, poultry, fruit, meats, vegetables, and all kinds of farm produce, and to transact all business incidental or appurtenant thereto.

To conduct and carry on the business of buying, selling and dealing, at wholesale and retail, in all kinds of grain, feed, ^{seed,} hay and other farm produce and farm products, livestock and provisions, coal, oil, wood and other kinds of fuel, and all other kinds of goods, wares and merchandise; and to do a general commission, and brokerage business in any or all of the foregoing kinds of property, and also to build, acquire, own, operate and maintain a

warehouse and storage business, and to do and transact all other business necessary or incidental to the conduct and carrying on of the business aforesaid.

To buy or otherwise acquire, own, hold, manage and control real and personal property of every description, including its own stock, and stock in any other corporations, and to sell and convey, mortgage, pledge, lease, or otherwise dispose of such property, or any part thereof, and to lend money either upon or without security.

To borrow money, issue bonds, debentures, and other obligations of the corporation, and to secure the same by mortgage or trust deed, or otherwise, on any or all of the real and personal property of the corporation, and to carry on any other lawful business which may seem to the Board of Directors capable of being conveniently carried on in any connection with the above purpose, or calculated directly or indirectly to enhance the value of or render profitable any of the corporation property or rights.

III

That the duration of time for which this corporation shall exist is to be perpetual.

IV

That the location and post office address of its registered office in this state is Pocatello, County of Bannock, State of Idaho.

V

That the capital stock of this corporation shall be \$25,000.00, divided into 250 shares at \$100.00 per share.

VI

The business of this corporation shall be managed by a Board of at least three directors. The number, qualifications, term of office, manner of election of directors, the time, place and manner of calling meetings, and the powers and duties of the directors, shall be prescribed by the by-laws.

VII
