CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

ETNA TECHNICAL SERVICES; INC.

Under Section 402 of the Business Corporation Law

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation pursuant to Section 402 of the Business Corporation Law of the State of New York, does bereby certify and set forth:

The name of this Corporation is Etna Technical Services, Inc. The purposes for which this Corporation is formed are as follows: firšt: SECOND:

To devise, formulate, and conduct business studies, surveys, computer reports, and tests; to furnish consultation and render business counsel with respect to loss control, administration, efficiency, maintenance, management, profit and safety functions; to provide actuarial, audit, productivity systems, electronic data processing, and other lawful services (including the publication or manufacture of educational or audio visual materials) to business, industrial, or charitable organizations, or to any association, partnership or corporation.

To investigate, collate, develop, and report information concerning exposures to loss; to adjust disputes and claims between or among individuals, partnerships, associations, firms, and corporations, the state or local subdivisions thereof, of whatsoever

nature; to examine, inspect, and appraise property of every kind and nature and to pass upon and report upon the same and exposures to loss thereon.

To make, purchase and otherwise acquire, sell, and otherwise dispose of maps, diagrams, plats, appraisements, and information of and concerning property of every kind and nature, and exposure to loss thereon.

To manufacture, process, convert, produce, buy, sell, license, distribute, wholesale, market and retail any and all products and services of any kind and description.

To provide services in the field of environmental sciences including, but not limited to, industrial hygiene; to inspect fire and casualty control and prevention systems; to make inspections and provide loss control services.

In general, to carry on any other business in connection with all of the foregoing whether manufacturing, distributing, selling or otherwise and to carry on any lawful business (except banking, insurance, or the operation of railroads) with all the powers conferred upon this Corporation by law.

THIRD: The office of this Corporation is to be located in the City of New York, County of New York, State of New York.

FOURTH: The aggregate number of shares which this Corporation shall have authority to issue is 1000 shares of Common Stock with a par value of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per share.

FIFTH:

The Secretary of State of the State of New York is hereby designated the agent of this Corporation upon whom process against this Corporation may be served.
