### CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, IRA H. MASTERS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

#### CHANEY FREIGHT LINE, INCORPORATED

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Third** day of **May** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty-**eight** and duly recorded in Book A- **31** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 29-103, Idaho Code, Annotated.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Boise** in the County of **Ada**.

## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

CHANNEY FREIGHT LINE, INCORPORATED.

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We, the undersigned, citizens of the United States and residents of the State of Idaho, and of legal age, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of organizing a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and for that purpose do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation,

### ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation shall be Chaney Freight Line, Incorporated.

### ARTICLE II.

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

### ARTICLE III.

The location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation in the State of Idaho shall be Boise, Idaho.

The total authorized number of shares of stock of the corporation shall be three hundred fifty (350) shares of a par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars a share; that the aggregate

par value of the authorized capital stock of said corporation shall be the sum of Thirty-five Thousand (\$35 000.00) Dollars.

#### ARTICLE V

The authorized capital stock of the corporation shall consist wholly of common stock and all of said capital stock shall have the same rights and voting power and shall be non-assessable for any purpose whatsoever.

#### ARTICLE VI.

The officers of the corporation shall be a Board of Directors, a President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer, and such other officers as may be designated by the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall be elected at the annual meeting of the shareholders and shall hold office for a period of one year or until their successors are elected and qualified. Any two or more offices of the corporation may be filled by one person in the discretion of the Board of Directors.

#### ARTICLE VII.

The annual meeting of the shareholders shall be held at the office of the corporation in the City of Boise, County of Ada, State of Idaho, on the first Saturday in February in each year, unless such day be a legal holiday, in which event said meeting shall be held on the next succeeding day which is not a legal holiday.

#### ARTICLE VIII.

The names and post office addresses of each of the incorporators, and the number of shares of stock subscribed by each are as follows:

#### IX.

The purposes for which said corporation is organized are as follows:

To own and operate a line or lines of automobile busses or motor trucks or both for the transportation of passengers and property for hire, and to act as principal, agent, broker, factor or otherwise in transporting and forwarding parcels, packages, merchandise and goods of all kinds and descriptions between cities, towns and localities, settlements, farms, and from all origins and destinations in any state in which the corporation is authorized to do business and to act as receiver and forwarder of goods, wares and merchandise of all descriptions from or to railroads, express companies, post offices and all other kinds of transportation agencies or places of business where goods are received or delivered for transportation; to engage in a general express business either on an agency, commission or bank exchange basis; to make application for, and to own, use, mortgage, sell or otherwise encumber and dispose of permits or certificates of convenience and necessity issued by any state or federal motor vehicle regulatory commission or tribunal of any kind or character

whatsoever for the operation of an auto freight, passenger, express, or other kind of transportation business in any state in which the corporation may be authorized to do business; to engage in the manufacture and sale, either at wholesale or retail, of motor vehicles, trailers, semi-trailers and motor vehicle equipment and accessories of every kind or character, gasoline, oils, and all other kinds of motor fuels and oils; to own, operate, sell, convey or encumber garages, service stations, freight depots or terminals or any other business of any kind necessary or convenient in the operation of a motor vehicle business.

To invest its capital stock or other funds of the corporation in stocks, bonds and securities, whether public or private; to purchase and sell such bonds, stock and securities; to discount notes and bills of exchange of every kind; to borrow money and to pledge or mortgage as security therefor any of the property of the corporation; to lend money on security or otherwise; to purchase, own, hold, sell, or encumber real estate and personal property, and to acquire the same in satisfaction of debts due or to become due.

In general to do act or thing permitted and authorized by the laws of any state in which said corporation shall be authorized to transact business in carrying on a motor freight, passenger or express service of any kind whatsoever, and to operate any kind or character of business incidental thereto, including but not limited to engaging in dealing in motor vehicles of all kinds, and all accessories and equipment for use in connection therewith, garages, gasoline filling stations and all other kinds of business relating to or connected with the use of motor vehicles.
