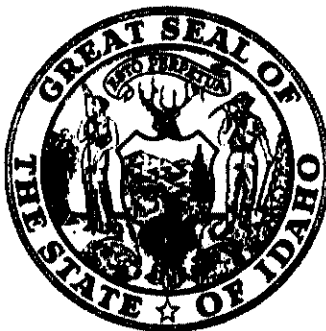
CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION OF

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
THE PENTECOSTAL TABERNACLE
INCORPORATED

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The undersigned, acting as incorporators under the Idaho Non-profit Corporation
Act, hereby adopt these Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I. NAME

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The name of this corporation shall be THE PENTECOSTAL TABERNACLE INCORPORATED.

ARTICLE II. PURPOSE

This church is organized exclusively for religious, charitable and educational purposes to govern itself according to the standards of the New Testament Scriptures, "endeavoring to keep the unity of the spirit in the bond of peace ---till we all come in unity of faith, and of the knowledge of the son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ; "Ephesians 4:3-13.

Section I. In connection therewith, or incidental thereto, it shall have the right to purchase or acquire by gift, bequest, or otherwise, either directly or as trustee, and to own, hold in trust, use, sell, convey, mortgage, lease or otherwise dispose of any real estate or chattels as may be necessary for the furtherance of its purpose; all in accordance with its constitution and by-laws, and to distribute to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Paragraph 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE III. TENETS OF FAITH

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This church shall accept the Holy Scriptures as the revealed will of God, the all sufficient rule for faith and practice, and for the purpose of maintaining unity in the Pentecostal Tabernacle.

ARTICLE IV. ORDINANCES

Section I. The ordinance of Baptism by immersion in water (Matthew 28:19) shall be administered to all those who have reported of their sins and who have believed on the Lord Jesus Christ to the saving of their souls, and who gave clear evidence of their salvation. Romans 6:3-5, Col. 2:12.

Section 2. The ordinance of the Lords Supper shall regularly be observed, as enjoined in the scriptures. Luke 22:19-20, 1 Cor. 11:23-26.

Section 3. Infants and small children may be dedicated to the Lord in the church, Mark 10:13-16, Luke 18:15,16.

Section 4. The sick should be prayed for, with the anointing with oil and the laying on of hands, upon their request. Mark 16:18, James 5:14.

ARTICLE V. MEMBERSHIP

Membership in this church shall be eligible to all those who give evidence of their faith in the Lord Jesus Christ, and who voluntarily subscribe to its tenets of faith and agree to be governed by its constitution and by-laws as herein set forth.

Section I. THE STANDARD OF MEMBERSHIP: The standard of membership of this Church shall be; (a) Evidences of a genuine experience in regeneration (the new birth) John 1:1-13, 3:3-8; 1 Peter 1:18-25. (b). Evidence of a consistent Christian life Rom. 6:4; 3:14; Eph. 4:17-32, 5:1, 2,15; 1 John 1:6-7. (c) To fully subscribe to the tenets of faith as set forth in the constitution. (d) Willingness to contribute regularly to the support of the church according to his or her ability.

Section 2. THE RECEPTION OF MEMBERS. (a) Persons desiring to become active members of the church shall make the fact known to the pastor, who shall examine the applicant according to the standard for membership.

ARTICLE VI. OFFICERS

The officers of this church shall consist of the pastor, three to five representative men who shall serve as advisory board and secretary-treasurer.

ARTICLE VII. MEETINGS

Section 1. Meetings for public worship shall be held on each Lord's day and during the week as may be provided for under the direction of the pastor.

Section 2. There shall be an annual business meeting of the church.

ARTICLE VIII. FINANCES

All funds for the maintenance of the church shall be provided by voluntary contributions or tithes and offerings of the members and friends of the church. Offerings shall be accepted by the church at such times and in such ways as agreed upon by the pastor, and shall be administered by the treasurer under his direction. Mal. 3:10, Luke 6:38, 1 Cor. 16:1, 2
11 Cor, 9:6-8

Section 1. All tithes is to go into a tithing account.

ARTICLE IX. ORDER BY-LAWS

In order to facilitate the conduct of business in an orderly and satisfactory manner, business meetings shall be governed by the accepted rules of parliamentary procedure in keeping with the spirit of Christian love, courtesy and fellowship.

ARTICLE X. AMENDMENTS

The by-laws may be amended at any regular or special business meeting of the church by a two-thirds majority vote of the membership present, provided the proposed amendment has been announced publicly on the two Sundays prior to the date of the meeting, announcement to be made by the Pastor or the Secretary.

ARTICLE XI. REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

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ARTICLE XI11. LIMITATIONS OF ACTIONS

No part of the funds of the Corporations shall inure to the benefit of, nor be distributed to, its officers or directors, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments in furtherance of the activities shall be caring on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in or intervene in any political campaign of any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE XIV. DURATION

The duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual. Upon the winding up and dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for paying all of the debts of the Corporation, distribute the remaining assets of the Corporation to a non-profit fund, foundation or corporation which has established its tax exempt status under Paragraph 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
