THE UNDERSIGNED, each with the capacity to contact, hereby submits, executes and acknowledges these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a corporation not for profit under the provisions of Title 30, Chapter 3, Idaho Code.

ARTICLE 1. NAME AND ADDRESS

The name of this corporation shall be The Church of Champions, Inc. The physical address of this corporation is 148 Blue Lakes Blvd. Suite 315, Twin Falls, Idaho 83301

ARTICLE 2. PURPOSE

This is a religious corporation. The specific purpose for which the corporation is initially organized is to establish and oversee places of worship, conduct the work of evangelism worldwide, create departments necessary to support missionary activities, to license and oversee ministers of the gospel, and to also engage in activities which are necessary, suitable or convenient for the accomplishment of that purpose, or which are incidental thereto or connected there with which are considered with Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for religious purpose within the meaning of Section 501(c)93), Internal Revenue Code.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation will not carry on any other activities nor permitted to be carried on by (i) a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United Stated Internal Revenue law, or (ii) a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or any other corresponding provision of any future United State Internal Revenue law. The purpose for this corporation is organized are exclusively charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

ARTICLE 3. QUALIFICATION OF MEMBERS AND MANNERS OF ADMISSION

This corporation will not have voting members.

ARTICLE 4. TERM

The date of commencement of corporation existence shall be when these Articles have been filed with the Department of State and approved by it and the respective filing fee has been paid; the term for which the corporation is to exist shall be perpetual. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for religious purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3), Internal Revenue Code. In the event of dissolution of the corporation, no part of the corporation's earnings or assets shall insure to the benefit of any of its members; the residual assets of the company shall be distributed to one or more organization which themselves are exempt as organization described in Section 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding sections of any prior or future law, or to the federal, state or local government for exclusive public purpose.

ARTICLE 5. NON PROFIT ORGANIZATION

No part of the net earning of the corporation shall ever insure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the terms of the corporation shall ever insure to the benefit of, or be

corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purpose set forth in Article 2. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statement) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on: (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law or: (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to the corresponding provisions of ant future United State Internal Revenue laws.

ARTICLES 6. INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

ARTICLE 8. DIRECTORS
