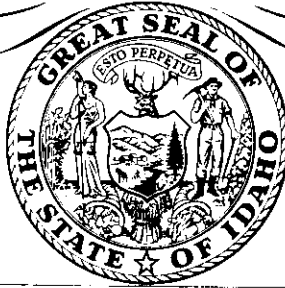

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Caldwell**, in the County of **Canyon**.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
D AND B SUPPLY COMPANY, INC.

natural persons of full legal age and citizens of the United States of America, we, the undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under and pursuant to the provisions of Section 30-102, I.C. of the Laws of the State of Idaho, do hereby associate ourselves as a body corporate and adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be D AND B SUPPLY COMPANY, INC.

ARTICLE II

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are: To purchase, manufacture, sell, rent, exchange and deal in at wholesale and retail all kinds of automobile and truck repair parts and accessories, tractors, farm machinery, electrical appliances, and all kinds of supplies and repair parts for automotive concerns and automotive and farm equipment, supplies, hardware goods, appliances and general commodities and business incidental thereto; to acquire, hold, lease, mortgage, encumber, exchange, convey and otherwise dispose of all real and personal property and business incidental thereto, or which may be conveniently conducted in connection with, or which may tend in any manner to promote any or all of the foregoing objects.

ARTICLE III

The existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

The location and post-office address of its registered office in this state shall be: 824 Cleveland Boulevard, Caldwell, Canyon County, Idaho.

ARTICLE V

The capital stock of this corporation shall be Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00), divided into Two Hundred Fifty (250) Shares of Common Stock of the par value of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) each.

ARTICLE VI

Said capital stock shall be paid in, in money or its equivalent, in such manner at such times and in such amounts as the Board of Directors shall direct.
