Attachment to Articles of Amendment (Non-Profit)
Gem State Rodeo Association, Inc.

Article 2:

a) To organize qualified amateur sports competition in the State of Idaho that promote rodeo for the purpose of promoting their mutual protection and benefit. This organization will be organized for the sole purpose of promoting amateur sports and not inure the benefit of private shareholders or individuals.

i) To require that all entrance fees are added to prize money with exceptions being at the discretion of the contestants.

ii) To secure competent, honest judges and officials in all events.

Article 8:

Upon dissolution of this organization, the assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
