The undersigned, in order to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the provisions of Title 30, Chapter 3, Idaho Code, submits the following articles of incorporation to the Secretary of State.

**ARTICLE I:** The name of the corporation shall be Conservation Voters for Idaho, Inc.

**ARTICLE II:** The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to promote social welfare within the meaning of section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code, including but not limited to, improving the environment and conserving natural resources through a variety of educational and advocacy activities, such as educating the public concerning the views and actions of public officials regarding conservation issues, training organizations and individuals, and engaging in legislative activities to improve the environment.

In carrying out its purposes, the corporation shall not have or exercise any power or authority granted to it under the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act, nor engage directly or indirectly in any activity, that would prevent it from qualifying as a corporation described in section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code. No part of the assets or earnings, current or accumulated, of the corporation shall at any time inure to the benefit of any private individual, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to make payments as reasonable compensation for services rendered and/or as a reasonable allowance for authorized expenditures incurred on behalf of the corporation and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its purposes.

The corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office to an extent that would disqualify it from tax exemption under section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code.

The corporation shall never be operated for the primary purpose of carrying on a trade or business for profit. The corporation may exercise all power or authority granted to it under the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act or otherwise, including, but not limited to, the power to accept donations of money, property, or any interest therein, or any other thing of value, and to own or lease property, whether real or personal.


