

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

ALLEN & LEWIS.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, John C. Lewis, L.A. Lewis, F.A. Spencer, of the City of Portland, Oregon, citizens of the United States and residents of the State of Oregon, do hereby form ourselves into a corporation, under and by virtue of the several Acts of the Legislative Assembly, of the State of Oregon, providing for the formation of corporations, and do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be Allen & Lewis, and its duration shall be unlimited.

ARTICLE II.

The enterprise, business pursuit and occupation in which this corporation proposes to engage is:

First: To engage in and conduct a general wholesale grocery and commission business.

Second. To export and import domestic and foreign merchandise and produce.

Third: To purchase, acquire, own, rent, hold, improve, lease, mortgage, sell, convey and dispose of real estate.

Fourth: To advance and lend money, and to take, receive and hold as security therefore, merchandise, produce, bonds, notes, and any other property whether real or personal; and to borrow moneys upon the security of real or personal property or otherwise:

Fifth: To own, lease and build wharves and warehouses and to conduct them.

Sixth: Lastly and generally to perform any and anything necessary, proper or convenient to carry into effects the objects and business aforesaid:

ARTICLE III.

The principal office and place of business of this corporation shall be at the City of Portland, County of Multnomah, State of Oregon;

ARTICLE IV.

The Capital Stock of this Corporation shall be Four Hundred Thousand (\$400,000.00) Dollars.

ARTICLE V.

Said Capital Stock shall be divided into Four Thousand Shares (4,000), and the par value of each share shall be One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.
