

Certificate

To whom it may concern:

This certifies that we the undersigned desire to form, and by these presents do form, the "South Field ditch and Canal Company," for the purpose of constructing and operating irrigating ditches and canals. That the capital stock of the said corporation shall be, in amount, the sum of Five thousand dollars, divided into five thousand shares of one dollar each. That the term of the existence of said corporation shall be twenty five years. That the number of trustees who shall manage the affairs and concerns of the company for the first three months, are John A Sutton of Paris Bear Lake Co. Idaho, H. J. Humphreys of Paris Bear Lake County Idaho and Minor Wilcox of Paris, Bear Lake County Idaho. That the principal place of business of said corporation shall be in the town of Paris, Bear Lake County Idaho.
