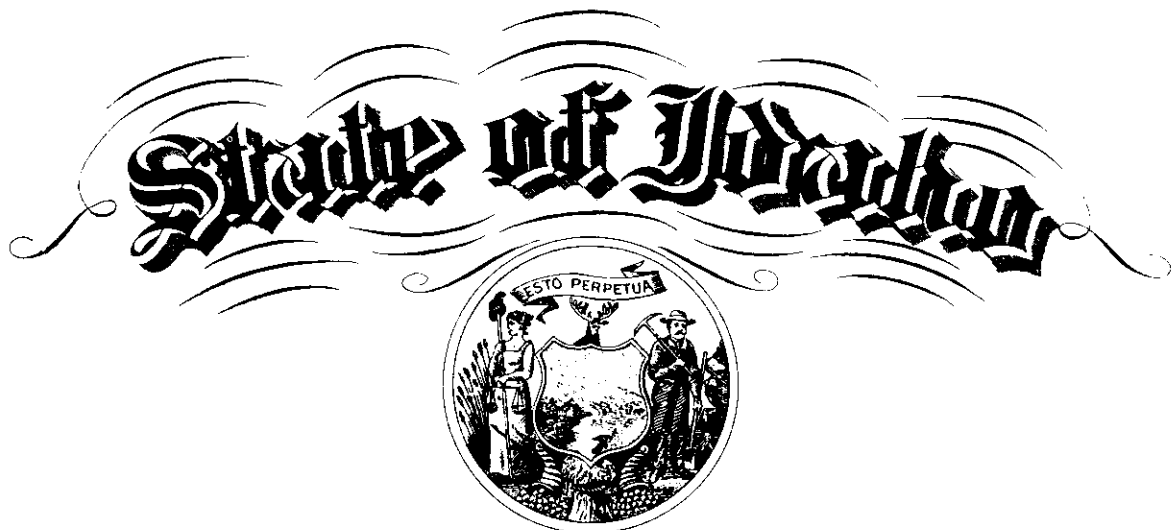




CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, JAS. H. YOUNG, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

CAPITOL SPORTSMAN'S CLUB, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **7th** day of **February** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Fifty-eight** and is duly recorded on Film No. **101** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103 and Sections 30-1001 to 30-1005, inclusive, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Boise** in the County of **Ada** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit Cooperative Associations as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

CARLOS SANTOS ANIS CLUB, INC.

Know all men by these presents, that we, the undersigned,

_____, _____,
_____, _____,

and _____, each being persons of full age,
residents of the State of Idaho, and citizens of the United States, associ-
ate ourselves together with the intention of forming a non-profit co-
operative association under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chap-
ter 10 of Title 30 of the Idaho Code, and we do hereby certify, declare
and adopt the following articles of incorporation.

I

The name of this association shall be the CARLOS SANTOS ANIS
CLUB, INC.

II

The nature, objects and purpose of this Association shall be:

a. To promote and foster interest in hunting, fishing and out-
door sports related thereto, and to promote the interests of the members
of this association, in the life of all types and descriptions and their
habitat.

b. To engage in any activity in connection with the hunting and
fishing; or any activity in connection with the renting, leasing, buying,
selling or manufacturing of guns, rifles or fishing equipment; or any
activity in connection with the repair or maintenance of guns, rifles or
fishing equipment; or any activity in connection with the purchase, hiring
or the use by the members of this association of guns, rifles or fishing
equipment parts, supplies, machinery, or equipment; or in the financing
of any of the above activities; or any one of the above activities spec-
ified herein.

c. To purchase or otherwise acquire, hold, own and exercise all
rights of ownership in, sell, transfer, cash or guarantee the payment of
dividends or interest on, or the retirement or redemption of, shares of

capital stock or bonds of any corporation or association or partnership or person engaged in any related activity which this association is authorized to engage in.

d. To establish reserves and invest the funds thereof in bonds or in such other property that may be provided for the by-laws of this association.

e. To construct, buy, sell, and exercise all privileges of ownership over such real and personal property as may be necessary and convenient for the purpose of this association or incidental thereto.

f. To levy assessments on the member and the amount as may be provided by the by-laws of this association and the laws of the State of Idaho.

g. To borrow money of any person, firm, or corporation, and to issue bonds, debentures or any other obligation of this association from time to time therefore, for any of the purposes or objects of this association and to secure the payment of the same by mortgage, pledge, deed or trust, or any other lawful means.

h. To do each and every thing necessary, suitable or proper for the accomplishment of any one or more of the purposes, or the attainment of any one or more of the objects herein enumerated, or conditions to or expedient in the interests of and benefits to this association, and contract accordingly; and in addition, exercise and possess all powers, rights or privileges necessary or incidental to the purposes of which this association is organized or to be engaged in when it is engaged; and, in addition, any other rights, powers and privileges, granted by the laws of the State of Idaho to any corporation except such as are inconsistent with express provisions of Title 30, Chapter 10, of the Idaho Code and any such laws or decrees.

i. To use or employ any of its facilities for any purpose, providing that the proceeds arising from such use and employment, shall go to the promotion of wildlife, together with the salary of operation

of fire arms and to secure legislation and government ruling conducive to the promotion and extension of hunting and fishing and wildlife habitat.

III

The period of existence and duration of the life of this association shall be perpetual.

IV

The location and post office address and the principal office for the transaction of business of this association shall be located in Boise, Idaho, County of Ada.

V

Under the terms and conditions described in the by-laws of this Association, this Association shall permit as its active members, all persons interested in hunting, fishing or wildlife. The voting power and the property rights or interests shall be vested in the active members only, whose fees are duly paid and who is in good standing; each such interest shall be equal, and no active member can have or acquire a greater interest than any other active member. The membership fees of this Association shall be fixed and determined by the by-laws of the Association, and when a member has paid his membership fee in full, he shall receive a membership certificate. The by-laws of this Association shall prohibit the assignment of membership certificates, except when such assignment of memberships are approved by a resolution of the board of directors of this Association, and under the regulations as the by-laws may prescribe and such restrictions shall be attached upon every membership certificate issued.

VI

The number of the directors of this Association shall be three (3), who must be active members or delegates or representatives of an active member, of this Association; the term of office shall be for a period of one (1) year, revivable, however, that the term of office of the directors who are to serve next shall extend on the day of the
