One Thousand Nine Hundred and twenty-six and is duly recorded in Book 1-19 of Domestic Corporations, Records of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 4696 of Idaho Compiled Statutes, to-wit:

FIRST, The name of the Corporation as aforesaid; SECOND, The purpose for which it was formed; THIRD, The place where its principal business is to be transacted; FOURTH, The term for which it is to exist; FIFTH, The number of its directors or trustees; SIXTH, The amount of its capital stock and the number of shares into which it is divided; SEVENTH, The amount of its capital stock actually subscribed and by whom.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate, by the name stated in the articles, for the term of fifty years.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
IDAHO TRANSIT COMPANY

We, W. E. Young, R. L. Campbell and M. L. Cherry, whose names are hereunto subscribed, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho for the formation of private corporations, and for that purpose do hereby make and adopt the following articles of incorporation:

ARTICLE I.

The name assumed by this corporation and by which it shall be known is IDAHO TRANSIT COMPANY.

ARTICLE II.

The objects and purposes and pursuits of this corporation, or business, in which it is to engage is that of owning and operating stages, busses and street cars without tracks or rails, using electric, steam or gasoline power, upon and over the highways, streets, avenues, boulevards and districts throughout the state of Idaho and any municipal or other legal subdivisions thereof, and to generally do, operate, control, build, maintain and own any and all businesses, property and things connected with a public stage, bus or street car system; to generally buy, sell and deal in all goods, wares, merchandise, machinery and vehicles ordinarily used in the operation of such bus and street car systems; to take and acquire franchises for the operation of a street car system; to acquire, purchase and take over any part or all of

the business, assets and liabilities of any person, firm, association or corporation now or hereafter engaged in a like business.

To take, acquire, purchase, hold, own, rent, lease, sell, exchange, mortgage, improve and otherwise deal in and dispose of any property, real or personal, of every description incidental to or capable of being used in connection with the aforesaid business.

#### ARTICLE III.

The principal office and place of business of this corporation shall be the City of Boise, County of Ada, State of Idaho.

#### ARTICLE IV.

The period of duration of this corporation shall be fifty (50) years.

#### ARTICLE V.

The number of directors of this Corporation shall be three.

#### ARTICLE VI.

The capital stock of this corporation shall be Fifty thousand (\$50,000.00) dollars to be divided into five hundred (500) shares of the par value of One hundred (\$100.00) dollars each.

#### ARTICLE VII.

The amount of capital stock actually subscribed is Seven thousand (\$7,000.00) dollars, which has been subscribed by W. E. Young fifty (50) shares; R. L. Campbell ten (10) shares; M. L. Cherry ten (10) shares.
