ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF ENHANCED MUSIC PRODUCTS CORPORATION

Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 30-1-1003 and 30-1-1006 of the Idaho Business Corporation Act (the "Act"), Enhanced Music Products Corporation, an Idaho corporation (the "Corporation"), hereby adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation:

FIRST: The name of the Corporation is Enhanced Music Products Corporation.

SECOND: Article I of the Articles of Incorporation is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be RECREATIONAL MUSIC, INC.

THIRD: The amendment does not provide for an exchange, reclassification or cancellation of any issued shares.

FOURTH: The foregoing amendment was adopted by the shareholders of the Corporation on April 28, 1998.
