

This is to verify that the undersigned do hereby associate themselves into a Corporation, under and by virtue of an act of the Legislature of the State of ~~####~~ New Jersey, entitled, An act concerning Corporations (Rev. 1896), and the several supplements thereto and acts amendatory thereof, and do severally agree to make the number of shares of stock set opposite their respective names,

First, The name of the Corporation shall be "Western Water Company,

Third, The Name of the Agent therein and in charge thereof upon whom process against this corporation may be served is the Corporation Trust Company of New Jersey,

Fourth, The object for which this Corporation is formed are as follows, The buying, selling, leasing, controlling, developing and irrigating lands located in the State of New Jersey, and other States and Territories, of the United States for purposes of Agricultural, Horticulture, Floriculture, Stockraising, Fruit raising, and sub-dividing and such lands into Town, Village or City lots for residence purposes, and to do and perform every act necessary to carry into effect the purposes for which such Corporation is formed. The Corporation shall have power to conduct its business in all its branches, have one or more Offices, and unlimitedly to hold, purchase, Mortgage, and convey Real estate and personal property in the State of New Jersey, and as well in all other States and Territories and in all foreign Countries, and especially in the State of Idaho.

Fifth, The total authorized capital stock of this Corporation is One hundred thousand dollars, divided into one thousand shares, of the par value of \$100.00 each.

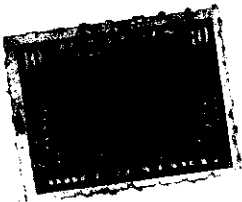
