ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

COLEMAN & POWELL, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all being citizens of the United States of America, and of full age, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho.

And we hereby certify in writing:

I.

That the name of said corporation shall be Coleman & Powell, Inc.

II.

That the purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

- (1) To buy, sell, own, operate, mortgage, lease, deal in and trade in any and all kinds and types of farm, ranch, urban and suburban lands and real estate.
- (2) To engage in the business of farming and ranching, the reclamation, irrigation, drainage and development of farms, farm lands and ranch lands, and to plant, grow, produce and developm buy, sell, handle, store, and otherwise acquire and exchange any and all types, varieties and kinds of agricultural products, and by-products, and to engage in the business of grading, sorting, preserving, processing and marketing thereof, either at wholesale or retail; to engage in the business of buying, selling, breeding, raising, fattening, processing and marketing either at wholesale or retail all types of livestock; and to do any and all things in connection with a general farming and livestock business.
- (3) To improve and develop real and personal property through the construction of buildings, construction and operation of irrigation works by diversion from natural streams, by wells and pumping projects or by any other means, or through any other method that seems necessary, desirable, or convenient to the directors of the corporation.

- (4) In the purchase or acquisition of property, business rights, or franchises or for any other object in or about its business or affairs, to incur debt and to borrow and secure the payment of money in any lawful manner, including the issue and sale or other disposition of bonds, debentures notes and other evidences of indebtedness.
- (5) To purchase its own stock for the following purposes: to reorganize its capital structure; to enter such stock on its books as treasury stock; to reissue such stock; to redeem such stock, and to deal and trade in such stock.
- (6) To act as surety or guarantor in any and all types of engagements including the power to execute, endorse and deliver contracts and to guarantee the prompt and faithful performance for payment of debts, notes, agreements, contracts and undertakings of any other person, firm, partnership, or corporation; and including also the power to act as accommodation co-maker or guarantor of obligations either as primary or secondary obligor.
- (7) To carry on any other kind of business or business activities that the Board of Directors may from time to time deem to be advisable or proper in connection with general farming and livestock business.

The several subdivisions contained in this statement of purposes shall be construed as both purposes and powers and the enumeration thereof shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the general powers conferred on this type of corporation by the laws of the State of Idaho, all of which are hereby expressly claimed.

III.

The term for which said corporation shall exist is perpetual.

IV.

That the registered office of said corporation in the State of Idaho shall be located in Twin Falls, in the County of Twin Falls, State of Idaho, and that the post office address of the registered office of said corporation in the State of Idaho is Twin Falls, Idaho.

That the amount of capital stock of said corporation shall be Twenty-

Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) divided into Two Hundred Fifty (250) shares of a par value of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) each, and that the total authorized number of shares shall be 250.
