ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
SAGA FOOD SERVICE OF IDAHO, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, under and pursuant to the provisions of the Idaho Business Corporation Act, and the acts amendatory thereto and supplemental thereto, do hereby certify as follows:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Saga Food Service of Idaho, Inc.

SECOND: The nature of the business of the corporation and the objects or purposes to be transacted, promoted or carried on by it are as follows:

To conduct the business of preparing food for human consumption, serving and selling the same as a caterer, as a concessionaire or as the owner, operator, lessee, of a restaurant, lunchroom, tea room, diner, snack bar, or any similar or like operation,

To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire, and to hold, own, sell or dispose of real and personal property of all kinds which may be necessary, convenient and suitable for the conduct of the business hereinabove described,

To borrow money for its corporate purposes and to make, accept, indorse, execute and issue promissory notes, bills of exchange, bonds, debentures or other obligations from time to time for the purchase of property or for any purpose in and about the business of the corporation and as deemed proper, to secure the payment of any such obligations by mortgage, pledge or otherwise,

To buy, lease or otherwise acquire and thereafter to carry on, the business of any person, firm or corporation or stock thereof engaged in any business which this corporation is authorized to carry on,

To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every sort and kind which may be necessary or convenient for the business of the corporation or business of a similar nature with any person, firm or corporation or any unit of government,

To acquire by purchase, exchange or otherwise, all, or any part of, or any interest in, the properties, assets, business and good will of any one or more persons, firms, associations or corporations heretofore or hereafter engaged in any business for which a corporation may now or hereafter be organized under the laws of the State of Idaho; to pay for the same in cash, property or its own or other securities; to hold, operate, reorganize, liquidate, sell, or in any manner dispose of the whole or any part thereof; and in connection therewith, to assume or guarantee performance of any liabilities, obligations or contracts of such persons, firms, associations or corporations, and to conduct the whole or any part of any business thus acquired,

To endorse or guarantee the payment of principal, interest or dividends upon, and to guarantee the performance of sinking fund or other obligations of, any securities, and to guarantee in any way permitted by law the performance of any of the contracts or other undertakings in which the corporation may otherwise be or become interested, of any persons, firm, association, corporation, government or subdivision thereof, or of any other combination, organization or entity whatsoever.

THIRD: The corporation is to have perpetual existence.

FOURTH: The location and post-office address of the registered office of the corporation is First Security Bank Building, c/o Ralph R. Breshears, City of Boise, County of Ada, Idaho.

FIFTH: The total authorized capital of the corporation shall be \$5,000.00 consisting of 500 shares of capital stock of a par value of \$10.00 per share.
