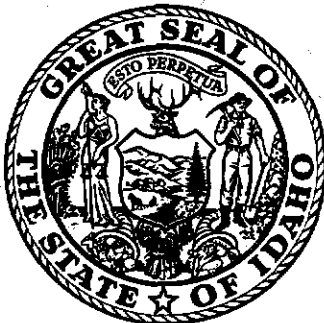

The Regular Meeting of the Wendell Village Board of Trustees was held in the City Hall on the above date.

The following members answered Roll Call S.P. Ramsey, W.E. Gates, J.R. Williams Clyde Peterson & M.L. Gates.

Minutes of last meeting were read & approved. Mr & Mrs Hillard Hunt appeared before the Board with a proposition that they might acquire lots 1 to 12 inc & 25 to 32 inc. in block # 73, now held by the City. After some discussion J.R. Williams made the motion that if Mr & Mrs Hunt were able to get purchase & move one of the Barracks from Hunt to these lots ~~mentioned above~~ the City would deed same to Mr & Mrs Hunt. This was 2nd by C. Peterson. Roll call found all members voting aye. Carried.

T. Gates moved that Harry M & Mitt be ~~granted~~ <sup>deeded</sup> by the City enough of the old Idaho Southern Grade fronting his lots 9-10-11-12 Block # 129 & 5-6-7-8 Block # 130, to make square & regular sized lots. This was 2nd by S. Ramsey. All members aye. Carried.

Mr. E. J. Parr & D. B. Bradshaws appeared before the Board concerning rates for industrial water users.

Clyde Peterson moved that the following rates be established 22,250 gallons at our present rate, ~~from that to~~ <sup>the next</sup> 177,750 gallons at the rate of 15¢ per M. all over 200,000 gallons at 10¢ per M. This was 2nd by T. Gates. Roll call found all in agreement. Carried.

## RESOLUTION DISCONTINUING THE ORGANIZATION OF THE VILLAGE OF WENDELL, IDAHO, AS A VIL- LAGE AND ORGANIZING IT AS A CITY OF THE SECOND CLASS:

It satisfactorily appearing to the Chairman and Board of Trustees of the Village of Wendell, Idaho, in regular session assembled, that the Village of Wendell, Idaho, contains more than 1000 inhabitants and desires to discontinue its organization as a village and to organize as a city of the second class, and that a written petition seeking such discontinuation and organization, signed by qualified electors of said village exceeding three-fifths of the total vote as shown by the last preceding general village election held in said village (April, 1945), has recently been filed with the village clerk of said village, and such petition appearing to be properly signed and filed and in order:

Now, Therefore, BE IT RESOLVED by the Chairman and Board of Trustees of the Village of Wendell, Idaho, that the organization of said village as a village shall be and hereby is discontinued, and it hereby is organized as a city of the second class, and shall henceforth be known as the "City of Wendell, Idaho".

Passed and approved unanimously by the Chairman and entire Board of Trustees of the Village of Wendell, Idaho this 14th day of February, 1947.
