ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned citizens of the United States of America, over the age of twenty-one years, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we certify in writing:

I

That the name of the corporation is CLARK REAL ESTATE CO.

II

That the purpose for which said corporation is formed is to engage in the general business of real estate and insurance; to subdivide property; to purchase, or otherwise, acquire, own, hold, lease, sell, exchange, assign, transfer, mortgage, or pledge, or otherwise dispose of, and deal in and with real property and any and all interest therein; likewise to own, hold, lease, sell, exchange, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of, and deal in and with personal property of every kind and nature incidental and necessary to the operation of the business; to enter into any kind of contract or agreement, co-operative or profit-sharing plan with its officers or employees that the corporation may deem advantageous or expedient or otherwise to reward or pay such persons for their services as the directors may deem fit; to acquire any property necessary or suitable for its purposes and to pay for the same in cash, in the stock or bonds of this company, or otherwise; to hold or in any manner dispose of the whole or any part of the business property acquired, and to exercise all the powers necessary or incidental to the conduct of such business.

To lend money and to negotiate and make loans, either on its own account or as agent or broker for others; to borrow money, to issue bonds, debentures, notes and other obligations of this corporation from time to time, or for any of the objects or purposes of this corporation, and to mortgage, pledge, hypothecate, and/or convey in trust, any or all of its property to secure the payment thereof; to discount and negotiate promissory notes, drafts, bills of exchange, and other evidences of debt,

to enter into make, perform and carry out contracts of every kind and for any lawful purpose, without limit as to amount, with any person, firm, association, corporation, municipality, state or government, or any subdivision, district or department thereof; to acquire interest in other corporations and firms; to do any and all such other things, acts, business, in any manner connected with or necessary, incidental, convenient or auxiliary to any of the objects hereinbefore enumerated, or calculated, directly or indirectly, to promote the interests of the corporation; and in carrying on its purposes, or for the purpose of obtaining or furthering any of its business, to do any and all acts and things, and to exercise any and all other powers, which a co-partner or natural person could do or exercise, and which now or hereafter may be authorized by law, and in any part of the world.

The several clauses contained in this statement of purpose shall be construed as both purposes and powers, and the statements contained in each clause shall in no wise limit or restrict by reference to, or inference from, the terms of any other clause, but shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers; and no recitation, express or declaration of specific or special powers or purposes herein enumerated shall be deemed to be exclusive; but it is hereby expressly declared that all other lawful powers not inconsistent herewith are hereby included.

III

That the term for which said corporation is to exist is perpetually.

IV

That the principal office and place of business of said corporation is the City of Pocatello, County of Bannock, State of Idaho.

V.

That the number of directors of said corporation shall be not less than three nor more than seven, as determined by the stockholders or directors of said corporation from time to time.

VI

That the amount of total authorized capital stock of this corporation is \$25,000 consisting of 250 shares of capital stock of the par value of \$100 per share, and the entire voting stock of this corporation shall be divided into equal 250 shares.

VII

That the amount of capital stock of said corporation which has actually been subscribed is three shares of capital stock. The following are the names of the subscribers, their addresses, and the number and par value of the shares subscribed for by each.
