ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

IDAHO CONSUMER AFFAIRS, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the under-
signed, each being a natural person of full age, and a citizen
of the United States of America, have voluntarily and do hereby
associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a
corporation not for profit under Section 30-117A, Idaho Code,
as amended, and under the laws of the State of Idaho in general,
and we do hereby certify, declare and adopt the following article
of incorporation:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be IDAHO CONSUMER
AFFAIRS, INC.

ARTICLE II.

The period of existence and duration of the life of
this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III.

The location of the registered office of this
corporation shall be in Boise, County of Ada, State of Idaho,
and the address of the registered office of this corporation
shall be 817 West Franklin Street, Boise, Idaho 83702.

ARTICLE IV.

The objects and purposes of this corporation shall be
as follows:

1. To promote sound legislation in the interest of
the consumer and to help insure its effective enforcement;
2. To make the consumer more aware of the practices
in the marketplace and to provide him with tools necessary
to buy wisely;

3. To provide the consumer with a voice before those agencies of government which regulate or affect those goods and services which he purchases;
4. To gather, to exchange and disseminate information of value to the consumer;
5. To assist and work for the coordination of other organizations and persons interested in the protection of the consumer;
6. To protect consumers;
7. To improve the general standard of living;
8. To help families spend the family income wisely through buying advice, unbiased comparative test reports, informative labeling of products;
9. To represent consumers before legislative bodies;
10. To provide advice on current legislation and other matters affecting family welfare;
11. To speak for consumers before public, industrial and commercial bodies;
12. To raise the hygienic conditions of production, improve processing, packaging, transportation and marketing of food products;
13. To improve the quality of goods and services;
14. To work with standardizing bodies in developing methods of test for consumer goods;
15. To provide consumers with information about frauds, rackets, false advertising, harmful products, unsafe machines;
16. To work in the interests of consumers; remain completely independent, free from pressures of business, industry, advertising or other commercial interests;
17. To work with other consumer organizations.

1 This corporation shall not engage in any form of trade
2 or commerce, or carry on any activity which will result in a
3 remunerative profit to the corporation or to its members. Any
4 income or profits received by this corporation shall be applied
5 only to the non-profit purposes and objectives of the corpor-
6 ation, and no part of the income shall inure to the benefit of
7 any officer or member thereof.

8 Subject to the foregoing limitations, and in
9 accordance with the objects hereinabove set forth, the further
10 objects, purposes, business and pursuits of this corporation
11 shall be as follows:

12 To receive gifts and grants of money and property of
13 every kind and to administer the same for cultural, charitable,
14 educational, social welfare, and civic uses and improvement,
15 and to do anything necessary or proper for the accomplishment
16 of these purposes.

17 To enter into, make and perform and carry out contracts
18 of every sort and kind with any person, firm, association or
19 corporation, municipality, body politic, country, territory,
20 district, state and government.

21 To purchase, subscribe for or otherwise acquire and own
22 hold, use, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage pledge, exchange,
23 or otherwise dispose of real and personal property of every kind
24 and description, including but not limited to shares of stock,
25 bonds, debentures, notes, evidences of indebtedness, and other
26 securities, contracts, or obligations of any corporation or
27 corporations, association or associations, domestic or foreign
28 and to pay therefor in whole or in part in cash or by exchanging
29 therefor stocks, bonds, or other evidences of indebtedness or
30 securities of this or any other corporation, and while the owner
31 or holder of any such real or personal property, stock, bonds,

1 debentures, notes, evidences of indebtedness or other securities,
2 contract, or obligations, to receive, collect and dispose of the
3 interest, dividends and income arising from such property,
4 and to possess and exercise in respect thereto, all the rights,
5 powers and privileges of ownership, including all voting
6 powers on any stocks so owned.

7 To draw, make, accept, endorse, discount, execute
8 and issue promissory notes, bills of exchange, and other
9 negotiable or transferrable instruments.

10 In the purchase or acquisition of property, business,
11 rights or franchises, or for additional working capital, or
12 for any other object in or about its business or affairs, and
13 without limit as to amount, to incur debts, and to raise, borrow,
14 and secure the payment of money in any lawful manner, including
15 the issue and sale or other disposition of bonds, debentures,
16 obligations, negotiable and transferrable instruments, and
17 evidences of indebtedness of all kinds, whether secured by
18 mortgage, pledge, deed of trust or otherwise.

19 To carry on any other activities which may seem to
20 the corporation capable of being conveniently carried on in
21 connection with its affairs or calculated directly or
22 indirectly to enhance the value of or render profitable
23 any of the corporation's property or rights.

24 The said corporation may perform any part of its
25 business outside the State of Idaho, in the other states, in the
26 District of Columbia, territories or possessions, or dependencies
27 of the United States.

28 To do each and all things set forth herein to the
29 same extent and as fully as natural persons might do or could do
30 in the State of Idaho, and in any other state, country or place.

31 The foregoing clauses shall be construed as objects,
32 purposes and powers; and it is hereby expressly provided that

1 any enumeration of specific powers shall not be held to limit
2 or restrict in any manner the powers of this corporation.

3 To do all and everything necessary, suitable, and
4 proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the
5 attainment of any of the objects or the furtherance of any of
6 the powers hereinbefore set forth, either alone or in association
7 with other corporations, firms, or individuals, and to do every
8 other act or acts, thing or things incidental or appurtenant
9 to or growing out of or connected with the aforesaid objects
10 or purposes or any part or parts thereof, provided the same be
11 not inconsistent with the laws under which this corporation
12 is organized.

13 ARTICLE V.

14 In furtherance, and not in limitation of the powers
15 confirmed by statute, the Board of Directors is expressly
16 authorized:

17 To make and alter By Laws of this corporation, and
18 to authorize and cause to be executed mortgages and liens upon
19 the real and personal property of this corporation.

20 This corporation may in its By Laws confer powers
21 upon its directors in addition to the foregoing, and in addition
22 to the powers and authorities expressly conferred upon them by
23 statute.

24 ARTICLE VI.

25 The corporation formed hereby shall have no capital stock
26 and shall be composed of members rather than shareholders. The
27 voting power, property rights and interests of each member are equal
28 New members may be admitted and shall be entitled to vote and to
29 share in the property of the association with the old members.

30 No interest of any member in this corporation shall
31 be assignable or transferrable, and no membership in this
32 association shall be considered as having any monetary value.

Any member may be expelled from the corporation upon the conditions, and for the reasons as may be specified in the By Laws.





ARTICLE VII.


