

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

THE UNDERSIGNED, a natural person over the age of twenty-one (21) years, acting as incorporator of ADVANCED FOREST SYSTEMS, Inc. under the Idaho Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of this corporation is: ADVANCED FOREST SYSTEMS, Inc.

ARTICLE II

DURATION

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSE

The purpose of this corporation will be to conduct all lawful business activity.

ARTICLE IV

POWERS OF THE CORPORATION

This corporation shall have all of the powers granted or allowed by the Idaho Business Corporation Act, as may be amended from time to time, and all of the powers necessary or convenient to effect any or all of the purposes for which this corporation is organized.

ARTICLE V

COMMON STOCK

This corporation shall have authority to issue 10,000 shares of Common Stock, no par value. The authorized and treasury stock

SHAREHOLDER RIGHTS

The shareholders of ADVANCED FOREST SYSTEMS, Inc. shall have preemptive rights to acquire shares of ADVANCED FOREST SYSTEMS, Inc.. The shareholders shall have the right to cumulate their shares when electing Directors of this corporation.

ARTICLE VIII

COMMENCING BUSINESS

This corporation shall not commence business until consideration of a value of at least \$1,000.00 has been received for the issuance of shares of Common Stock.

No contract or other transaction between this corporation and one or more of its Directors or any other corporation, firm association or entity in which one or more of its Directors are directors or officers or are financially interested, shall be either void or voidable because of such relationship or interest, or because such Director of Directors are present at the meeting of the Board of Directors, or a committee thereof, which authorizes, approves or ratifies such contract or transaction, or because his or their votes are counted for such purpose if: (a) the fact of such relationship or interest is disclosed or known to the Board of Directors or committee which authorizes, approves or ratifies the contract or transaction by vote or consent sufficient for the purpose without counting the vote or consent of such interested Director; or (b) the fact of such relationship or interest is disclosed or known to the shareholders entitled to vote and they authorize, approve or ratify such contract or transaction by vote or written consent; or 6 the contract or transaction is fair and reasonable to the corporation. Common or interested Directors may be counted in determining the presence of a quorum at a meeting of the Board of Directors or committee thereof which authorizes, approves or ratifies such contract or transaction.
