

and such other persons as are or may become shareholders in the Trust Company hereby created under the provisions of the said Act a body corporate and politic with perpetual succession under a common seal by the name of

SEAWAY TRUST COMPANY

and, so long as the Company stands duly registered in the terms of the said The Loan and Trust Corporations Act, capable of exercising all the functions of an incorporated company for the purposes and objects aforesaid, and capable by their corporate name of suing and being sued, pleading and being impleaded in all courts, whether of Law or Equity, and with the powers, rights, limitations, duties and obligations by the law from time to time of Our said Province conferred and imposed upon a Trust Company incorporated under The Loan and Trust Corporations Act and the incorporation hereby granted shall be without limitations of time and area;

AND WE DIRECT that the said TRUST COMPANY shall not borrow money by taking deposits or by issuing debentures or debenture stock;

AND WE FURTHER DIRECT that the said Company be constituted with fixed, permanent and non-withdrawable capital of Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000) divided into Five Hundred Thousand (500,000) shares of the par value of Ten Dollars (\$10,00) each,

AND WE FURTHER DIRECT that the said Company have its Head Office in the City of Port Colborne, in the Regional Municipality of Niagara, in the Province of Ontario.
